



## NRCan Reminder – Importing Regulated Energy-Using Products

April 2009

Canada's *Energy Efficiency Act and Energy Efficiency Regulations* prohibit the importation of certain energy-using products (for the purpose of sale or lease) unless specific requirements are met by importers/dealers

### Importing Requirements

NRCan five data elements required for customs release:	
1. Name of the product (eg. dishwasher)	3. Brand name (if any)
2. Model number of the product (for motors, the unique motor identifier)	4. Address of the dealer
	5. Purpose of the importation
