

APPLYING FOR A CANADIAN PASSPORT?

The keys to a successful application



PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

- If you are a Canadian living in Canada or the United States, choose one of the following forms:
 PPTC 054 (simplified renewal for adults)
 PPTC 153 (adults 16 years of age or over)
 PPTC 155 (children under 16 years of age)
- To avoid any delays, please ensure that you answer all questions, particularly those in the section on **Proof of Canadian Citizenship**.

REQUIREMENTS:

GENERAL PASSPORT APPLICATION

- A completed application form (PPTC153 for adults and PPTC 155 for children) signed by the applicant and guarantor
- **Two** identical passport photos—one signed by the guarantor
- **Original** proof of citizenship (no copies)
- **At least one piece** of identification, government issued, in the name requested on the passport
- Any Canadian travel document issued in the past five years
- **All** custody documents regarding children
- Payment of the correct fee (cash payment not accepted)

SIMPLIFIED RENEWAL

- A completed application form (PPTC 054) signed by the applicant
- **Two** identical passport photos
- Any Canadian travel document issued in the past five years
- Payment of the correct fee (cash payment not accepted)

FEES:

Children (3 to 15 years)	C\$37	C\$37
Children (under 3 years)	C\$22	C\$22
