# **Harbour Authority User Fee Information**


Harbour Authorities throughout Newfoundland and Labrador charge user fees, typically in the form of berthage and landing charges. These fees are used to cover a Harbour Authority's ongoing minor maintenance requirements, salaries, water, electricity and other services.

User fees are to be established based on the financial and operational requirements of each individual Harbour Authority and can vary considerably depending upon the level of service/amenities provided within a particular harbour.

Please note the following information is intended as a guide only.



# **NL Region, Small Craft Harbours Areas**



The Small Craft Harbours NL Region is divided into four areas: Eastern Newfoundland; Central Newfoundland and Northern Labrador; Western Newfoundland and Southern Labrador; and, Southern Newfoundland.

# **Berthage Fees**

This table provides you with a guideline of the approximate annual fees Harbour Authorities are presently charging for commercial fishing vessel berthage based on the size of the harbour and the number of vessels. The table was produced using data from fee schedules from 125 Harbour Authorities throughout Newfoundland and Labrador.

Berthage (feet)	Small Harbour	Medium Harbour	Large Harbour
Less than 34'11"	\$50	\$50	\$100
35' - 44'11"	\$100	\$100	\$160
45' - 54'11"	\$140	\$140	\$190
55' - 64'11"	\$170	\$190	\$250

# **Landing Fees**

Many Harbour Authorities throughout Newfoundland and Labrador charge landing or off-loading fees. The majority of Harbour Authorities are charging between 0.25 to 0.50 cents per pound for landing fees.

#### **User Fees - Other**

In addition to berthage and landing fees, there are many other services that a Harbour Authority can charge for:

- Use of wharf
- Electrical fees
- Water usage
- Fuel truck access
- Launching fees
- Upland storage
- Waste oil disposal
- Licences
- Parking
- Recreational vessel berthage

For the purposes of the user fee study, harbours were classified as:

- Small Harbours—less than 50 vessels and less than 1 million pounds in landings.
- Medium Harbours—between 50-100 vessels and between 1 to 5.5 million pounds in landings.
- Large Harbours—more than 100 vessels and more than 5.5 million pounds in landings.
