Under the authority of the *Pest Control Products Act*, Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has registered the end-use products Harmony Grass 128EC Herbicide and Horizon NG Herbicide, containing technical grade clodinafop-propargyl, for use on spring and Durum wheat. The specific uses approved in Canada are detailed on the product labels of Harmony Grass 128EC and Horizon NG, *Pest Control Products Act* Registration Numbers 29202 and 29089, respectively.

A corresponding maximum residue limit (MRL) was proposed in the consultation document published on 10-Mar-2010, Proposed Maximum Residue Limit PMRL2010-18, *Clodinafop-propargyl*. The PMRA received no comments in response to this consultation.

To comply with Canada's international trade obligations, consultation on the proposed MRL was also conducted internationally by notifying the World Trade Organization, as coordinated by the Standards Council of Canada. No comments were received as a result of the World Trade Organization consultation.

The following MRL takes legal effect as of the publication date of this document.
