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Under the authority of the *Pest Control Products Act*, Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has granted conditional registration to technical grade thien carbazole-methyl and the end-use products AE1162464 WG 63 Herbicide and Velocity Herbicide for use in Canada on field corn and wheat. The specific uses approved in Canada are detailed on the product labels of AE1162464 WG 63 Herbicide (field corn) and Velocity Herbicide (wheat), *Pest Control Products Act* Registration Numbers 29069 and 29070, respectively.

Corresponding maximum residue limits (MRLs) were proposed in the consultation document published on 16 November 2010, Proposed Maximum Residue Limit PMRL2010-53, *Thien carbazole-methyl*. In addition, import MRLs for thien carbazole-methyl in or on popcorn grain and sweet corn were proposed in PMRL2010-53. The PMRA received no comments in response to this consultation.

To comply with Canada's international trade obligations, consultation on the proposed MRLs was also conducted internationally by notifying the World Trade Organization, as coordinated by the Standards Council of Canada. No comments were received as a result of the World Trade Organization consultation.

The following MRLs for thien carbazole-methyl in Canada take legal effect as of the publication date of this document.
