Under the authority of the *Pest Control Products Act*, Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has converted the conditional registrations of Folicur Technical Fungicide and the end-use product Folicur 432 F Foliar Fungicide, containing technical grade tebuconazole, to full registrations, *Pest Control Products Act* Registration Numbers 25763 and 25940, respectively.

After the evaluation of additional residue trials submitted in support of the conversion, it was determined that a higher MRL than currently established for wheat was warranted. A corresponding MRL was proposed in the consultation document published on 24 November 2010, Proposed Maximum Residue Limit PMRL2010-74, *Tebuconazole*. The PMRA received no comments in response to this consultation.

To comply with Canada's international trade obligations, consultation on the proposed MRL was also conducted internationally by notifying the World Trade Organization, as coordinated by the Standards Council of Canada. No comments were received as a result of the World Trade Organization consultation.

The following MRL takes legal effect as of the publication date of this document and replaces the 0.05 ppm MRL previously established for tebuconazole on wheat.
