Under the authority of the *Pest Control Products Act*, Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has converted the conditional registration of technical grade aminoethoxyvinylglycine hydrochloride and the end-use product ReTain Plant Growth Regulator to full registration. The specific use on apples approved in Canada is detailed on the label of ReTain Plant Growth Regulator, *Pest Control Products Act* Registration Number 25609.

A corresponding MRL was proposed in the consultation document published on 7 December 2010, Proposed Maximum Residue Limit PMRL2010-82, *Aminoethoxyvinylglycine Hydrochloride*. The PMRA received no comments in response to this consultation.

To comply with Canada's international trade obligations, consultation on the proposed MRL was also conducted internationally by notifying the World Trade Organization, as coordinated by the Standards Council of Canada. No comments were received as a result of the World Trade Organization consultation.

The following MRL for aminoethoxyvinylglycine hydrochloride takes legal effect as of the publication date of this document.
