Tralkoxydim

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Under the authority of the *Pest Control Products Act*, Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) has re-evaluated the human health and environmental risk as well as the value of tralkoxydim and has granted continuing registration of products containing tralkoxydim for sale and use in Canada. Details regarding the decision can be found in Re-evaluation Decision RVD2011-01, *Tralkoxydim*, published on 31 January 2011.

As a result of the re-evaluation, MRLs were proposed for tralkoxydim in the consultation document published on 23 June 2011, Proposed Maximum Residue Limit PMRL2011-19, *Tralkoxydim*. The PMRA received no comments in response to this consultation.

To comply with Canada's international trade obligations, consultation on the proposed MRLs was also conducted internationally by notifying the World Trade Organization, as coordinated by the Standards Council of Canada. No comments were received as a result of the World Trade Organization consultation.

The following MRLs take legal effect in Canada as of the publication date of this document and are in addition to the MRLs already established for tralkoxydim.
