Cyber Security

In the wake of the Wikileaks, Canadian media has been reporting on cyber security and cyber attacks in Canada. In this evolving climate of cyber attacks, the Government of Canada and private industry in Canada must be increasingly diligent in protecting and safeguarding sensitive government information stored and transmitted electronically.

On October 5, 2010, Public Safety Canada released a report entitled *Canada's Cyber Security Strategy*. The Honourable Vic Toews, Minister of Public Safety, stated in his message: "Our systems are an attractive target for foreign military and intelligence services, criminals and terrorist networks. These groups are breaking into our computer systems to crash. They are stealing our industrial and national security secrets, and our personal identities." *Canada's Cyber Security Strategy* outlines types of cyber threats in Canada as well as measures that Canadians, Canadian industry and the Government of Canada must take to safeguard and ensure our cyber security.

Some interesting statistics from the report:

- 74% of Canadian households have paid Internet service in 2008
- 59% of personal tax filings were electronic in 2008
- 67% of Canadians banked online in 2009
- Canadian online sales were \$62.7 billion in 2007
- 87% of Canadian businesses used the Internet in 2007

<u>New Bilateral Industrial Security Arrangement</u> with Spain

On January 20, 2011, PWGSC's International Industrial Security Directorate signed a new bilateral industrial security arrangement with the National Intelligence Centre in Spain.

The arrangement sets out clauses for the administration and application of industrial security contracts involving the protection of exchanged information between Canada and Spain. This arrangement is expected to generate trade opportunities for Canadian industry and improve industrial cooperation between Canada and Spain. With the appropriate Facility Security Clearance, Canadian private sector companies can now qualify to bid on and participate in sensitive government contracts with Spain. Contracting Authorities are also able to receive the appropriate contract clauses through the Industrial Security Sector (ISS).
