

Foreign Credentials Referral Office (FCRO):

The FCRO provides information, path-finding and referral services on foreign credential recognition to help internationally trained workers (ITWs) integrate into the Canadian labour market. The FCRO also works with employers to strengthen their foreign credential recognition (FCR) capacity.

FCRO tools include:

- The Employer's Roadmap, a guide for small to mediumsized enterprises interested in hiring ITWs for their organizations.
- The Federal Internship for Newcomers Program that matches qualified newcomers with internships in the federal public service and the private sector.
- The International Qualifications Network website where you can learn about and share FCR best practices.
- Planning to Work in Canada? An Essential Workbook for Newcomers and the Occupational Facts brochures that help newcomers navigate the labour market.
