Racism-Free Workplace Strategy

The Government of Canada's Racism-Free Workplace Strategy (RFWS) promotes fair, inclusive and productive workplaces for all workers. It aims to eliminate barriers faced by visible minorities and Aboriginal peoples in the workplace. It also aims to increase the effectiveness of the *Employment Equity Act* and Federal Contractors Program.
