

2013 Competition Statistics Postgraduate Scholarships, Alexander Graham Bell Canada Graduate Scholarships, and Postdoctoral Fellowships Programs

This report includes tables and figures that provide summary information on the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council of Canada (NSERC)'s 2013 Postgraduate Scholarships (PGS), Alexander Graham Bell Canada Graduate Scholarships (CGS) and Postdoctoral Fellowships (PDF) competitions. Competition for these awards has been intense. NSERC was able to offer a similar number of CGS master's (CGS M) and CGS doctoral (CGS D) awards as compared with last year. In keeping with the requirements of the *Financial Administration Act*, NSERC has offered the exact number of awards corresponding to the available budget and will, in a second wave, make additional offers once the number of declines is known.

more applications than this quota. ³ Canadian universities are tasked with the selection of the USRA-University recipients and their respective quota is the number of awards they have to give. USRA Quotas listed are for the 2012 competition.

Direct applicants are those who submitted their application to NSERC directly, without going through the screening process at a Canadian university. Students registered at a foreign organization or; not currently registered at a university; or are registered, but not in a degree program; and have graduated from a degree program from a Canadian university since January 1 of this year are eligible to submit applications this way. Awards offered with conditions are excluded.

Figure 1 Percentage of Total PGS Applications at Master's Level versus Doctoral Level – 2005-2013






Figure 2 Gender Distribution of Applicants – 2013
