In Brief

The editing revisions made in this memorandum do not affect or change any of the existing policies or procedures.

This memorandum provides a stable link to the Department of Justice for the official version of the <u>NAFTA</u> <u>Rules of Origin Regulations</u> that are used to determine the entitlement of goods to preferential tariff treatment under the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA).
