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## CANADA-JORDAN FREE TRADE AGREEMENT (CJFTA) RULES OF ORIGIN

### *CJFTA Rules of Origin Regulations*

#### **Rules of Origin**

1. The following provisions of the Free Trade Agreement between Canada and the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, signed on June 28, 2009, have the force of law in Canada:

- (a) Articles 4-1 and 4-2;
- (b) Article 4-3, paragraph 1;
- (c) Articles 4-4 to 4-13;
- (d) Article 4-15; and
- (e) Annex 4-1.

#### **Coming Into Force**

2. These Regulations come into force on the day on which section 32 of the *Canada-Jordan Economic Growth and Prosperity Act*, chapter 18 of the Statutes of Canada, 2012, comes into force.

3. Annex 4-1: Specific Rules of Origin sets out the product specific rules of origin that establish the point at which materials or components have undergone sufficient production within the free trade area for the good produced to be considered originating.
