CUSTOMS NOTICE 13-021

Amendment to the Departmental Consolidation of the Customs Tariff

- 1. The Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) wishes to advise of an amendment to the *Departmental Consolidation of the Customs Tariff* effective November 29, 2013.
- 2. Pursuant to the Notice of Ways and Means Motion tabled in the House of Commons on November 22, 2013, a second supplementary note has been added to Chapter 16 of the *Customs Tariff*, that reads:

Where the components of food preparations of a type used commercially in the preparation of fresh food products for direct sale to a consumer include cheese, those components are to be classified separately, in their respective headings, regardless of their packaging.

3. An amended version of the *Departmental Consolidation of the Customs Tariff*, reflecting this change, has been posted on the CBSA's Web site.

- 4. For certainty regarding the tariff classification of a product, importers may request an advance ruling on tariff classification. Details on how to make such a request can be found in the CBSA Memorandum D11-11-3, Advance Rulings for Tariff Classification, which can also be found on the CBSA Web site.
