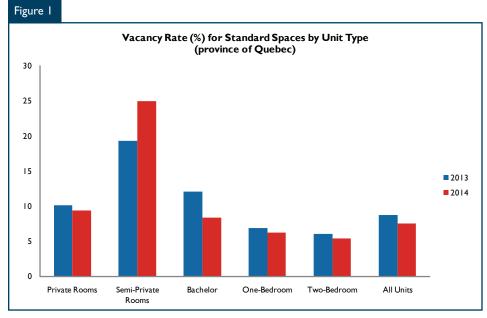

# **Highlights**

- The vacancy rate for standard spaces in Quebec decreased over the past year, reaching 7.5 per cent in February 2014 from 8.7 per cent at the same time in 2013.
- In February 2014, the average rent for standard spaces was \$1,557 per month.
- At the time of the survey, the capture rate was 18.6 per cent, a level slightly higher than the average of recent years.

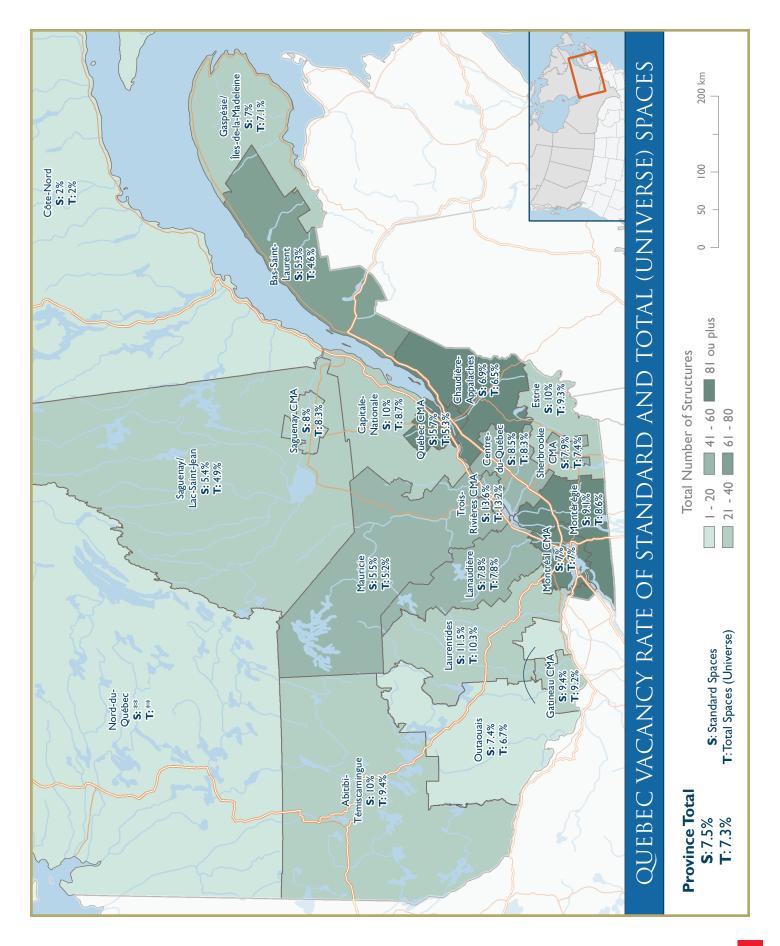

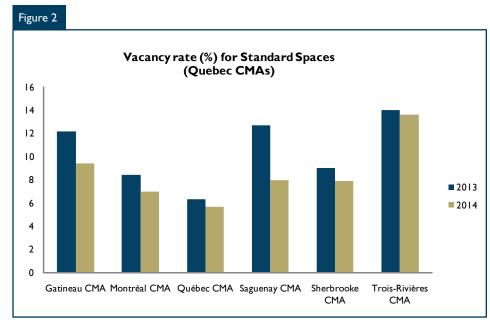
## Vacancy rate falls in 2014

According to the latest Seniors' Housing Survey conducted in Quebec by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC), the vacancy rate for standard spaces decreased over the past year, falling to 7.5 per cent in February 2014 from 8.7 per cent at the same time in 2013. This was a relatively low level compared to the average of recent years (8.3 per cent for the period from 2009 to 2013).

This tightening of the seniors' housing market resulted from demand rising faster than supply.

On the demand side, the growth in the population aged 75 years or older—the main client group for seniors' residences—picked up slightly, as this segment posted a gain of 2.7 per cent in 2014. As well, over the past year, the number of seniors living in residences grew more rapidly than the population aged 75 years or older. As a result, the proportion of Quebeckers aged 75 years or older living in residences increased, with the capture rate having reached 18.6 per cent in 2014, a level slightly higher than the average of recent years (17.6 per cent for the period from 2009 to 2013).

In some centres, however, the supply of spaces in residences continued to face competition from the recent increase in certain substitute products, particularly condominium (ownership or rental) apartments and traditional rental apartments. While these housing types do not offer the same range of services as those provided

in residences, they were still able to meet the needs of part of the demand for spaces in retirement homes, especially among independent seniors.

The supply of spaces in residences also rose, but less in proportion to demand. There were 108,438 spaces this past February, for an increase of 6.2 per cent over the same period in 2013.

Overall, these movements in supply and demand resulted in a decrease in the vacancy rate for standard spaces on the seniors' housing market. After having stagnated in recent years, this recent increase in demand could be a sign that this market is starting to pick up again. Indeed, over the next few years, according to the outlook<sup>2</sup>, the population aged 75 years or older will post further gains and show stronger growth starting in 2016.

# Vacancy rate remains higher for rooms

As in past years, the vacancy rate remained higher for rooms than for apartments. Still, the proportions of vacant standard spaces decreased for both types of units. In the case of apartments, the vacancy rate reached 6.5 per cent in 2014, compared to 7.8 per cent in 2013. For private rooms, this proportion fell to 9.4 per cent in 2014 from 10.2 per cent in 2013. Semi-private rooms, for their part, had the highest vacancy rate (25.0 per cent), but they accounted for less than I per cent of the universe of spaces in residences across the province at the time of the survey.

# Average rent higher for larger apartments

The average rent for all standard spaces rose from \$1,520 in 2013 to \$1,557 in 2014. The average rent for room spaces (\$1,502) was slightly lower than the average for all types of apartment spaces combined (\$1,588). For apartments, in general, the rents were higher with the number of bedrooms. In fact, two-bedroom units had an average rent (\$2,031) that was higher than the averages for one-bedroom units (\$1,544) and bachelor units (\$1,260).

# Market conditions tighten slightly for heavy care spaces

For heavy care spaces, that is, spaces where the residents pay an extra amount to receive 1.5 hours or more of care per day, market conditions tightened slightly over the past year. In fact, the vacancy rate for such spaces fell from 5.2 per cent in 2013 to 4.9 per cent in 2014. In this year's survey, 7,438 heavy care spaces were enumerated, representing almost 7 per cent of the universe of residence spaces in the province. The average monthly rent for spaces of this type was \$2,656.

# Large urban centres

While retirement home market conditions tightened in all census metropolitan areas (CMAs), the results varied greatly from one urban centre to another across Quebec. The greatest vacancy rate drops were registered in the Gatineau and Saguenay areas, while the survey results showed more modest decreases in the Québec, Sherbrooke and Montréal CMAs.

Nearly two-thirds of the places listed in Québec are located in the CMAs. Montreal CMA detained about 42 per cent of the places in the province.

#### Montréal CMA

In the Montréal CMA, the vacancy rate for standard spaces fell from 8.4 per cent in 2013 to 7.0 per cent in 2014. This was a relatively low rate compared to the average of the last years (8.3 per cent for the period from 2009 to 2013). The proportion of vacant spaces remained lower in the case of apartments (6.2 per cent) than for rooms (9.6 per cent). An analysis by geographic sector revealed that the overall vacancy rates were lower in the suburban sectors (between 2.9 per cent and 6.0 per cent) than on the Island of Montréal (9.5 per cent). The average monthly rent for standard spaces reached \$1,626 this year. The average rents were lower on the Island of Montréal (\$1.616) and in the Laval-North Shore sector (\$1,604) than on the South Shore (\$1,680) and in Vaudreuil-Soulanges (\$1,724). As well, the capture rate in the CMA was 17.4 per cent, which was slightly below the provincial average of 18.6 per cent.

# **Québec CMA**

The Québec CMA still had the tightest market conditions among the CMAs across the province. As was the case at the provincial level, the vacancy rate in the Québec area decreased, reaching 5.7 per cent in 2014 (compared to 6.3 per cent in 2013). Market conditions tightened for all types of units, except two-bedroom apartments, for which the vacancy rate increased to 3.7 per cent this year (from 3.1 per cent in 2013). The tighter conditions observed for the

overall CMA did not, however, extend to all geographic sectors. Vacancy rate increases were registered in several zones, including the East part of the Northern Suburbs, which in fact had the highest proportion of vacant standard spaces (10 per cent). Conversely, the Québec des Rivières zone had the lowest vacancy rate in the CMA (2.9 per cent, compared to 4.8 per cent in 2013). The average monthly rent for standard spaces in the area was estimated at \$1,634, according to the survey results. The average rent in the Northern Suburbs (\$1,774) was higher than the averages in the North Centre (\$1,587) and on the South Shore (\$1,595). The capture rate in the CMA reached 22.3 per cent, a level above the provincial average of 18.6 per cent.

#### Gatineau area

The vacancy rate for standard spaces in the Gatineau area reached 9.4 per cent in 2014, down by about three percentage points from 2013. In fact, since 2010, the proportion of vacant spaces in retirement homes in the area has been steadily declining, as a result of the relatively stable supply of such spaces and the small increase in the population aged 75 years or older. Market conditions tightened for apartments of all types, while the vacancy rate increased in the case of rooms, reaching 10.9 per cent this year, versus 8.0 per cent in 2013. Estimated at \$1,872, the average monthly rent for standard spaces in the Gatineau area was the highest among all CMAs in the province. By sector, the average monthly rents were \$1,993 in the West sector of Gatineau and \$1,796 is the East sector. The capture rate in the Gatineau area reached 20.1 per cent, a level slightly above the provincial average of 18.6 per cent.

### Sherbrooke CMA

In the Sherbrooke CMA, the vacancy rate for standard spaces decreased further over the past year, falling from 9.0 per cent in 2013 to 7.9 per cent in 2014. This drop was felt mainly in the case of apartment spaces, for which the vacancy rate declined from 8.7 per cent in 2013 to 6.4 per cent in 2014, and resulted from the stable supply of spaces and the increase in the population aged 75 years or older in the area—the main client group for seniors' residences. Among the large sectors of the CMA, the vacancy rates reached 10.1 per cent in the city of Sherbrooke (pre-merger), 4.3 per cent in Magog and 3.7 per cent in the suburbs. As well, out of the CMAs in the province, the Sherbrooke area had the second highest capture rate, at 25.7 per cent in 2014. The average monthly rent for standard spaces reached \$1,403, according to the 2014 survey results.

#### **Trois-Rivières CMA**

Market conditions also tightened slightly in the Trois-Rivières CMA. The proportion of unoccupied standard spaces in the area reached 13.6 per

cent in 2014, in comparison with 14.0 per cent in 2013. Even though the vacancy rate decreased, the Trois-Rivières CMA continued to post the softest market conditions among the province's six CMAs. The tightening of the market was observed for apartments of all types. However, the vacancy rate for private rooms increased, reaching 11.8 per cent this year, compared to 7.7 per cent in 2013. In Trois-Rivières Centre, Trois-Rivières (vacancy rate of 15.1 per cent) was the only one zone that saw its market conditions tighten. The vacancy rates went up in all other zones of the CMA. The Capde-la-Madeleine zone had the tightest market conditions (vacancy rate of 3.4 per cent), while the outlying sector had the highest vacancy rate in the CMA (22.7 per cent). The average monthly rent for standard spaces was \$1,576, according to the 2014 survey results. From a geographic standpoint, the average rents reached \$1,620 in Trois-Rivières Centre and \$1,409 in the outlying sector. In 2014, the area had the highest capture rate among the CMAs in the province, at 27.0 per cent.

## Saguenay CMA

Among the CMAs in the province, Saguenay posted the greatest change in the vacancy rate for standard spaces, as the rate there fell from 12.7 per cent in 2013 to 8.0 per cent in 2014. This tightening of the market was attributable to a stable supply, combined with a slight increase in demand. The decline in the vacancy rate, which began in 2013, was observed in both the room and apartment segments. Market conditions tightened significantly in the Jonquière zone, where the vacancy rate dropped from 16.6 per cent last year to 10.1 per cent this year. This zone still had the softest conditions, though, while La Baie continued to have the tightest, with a vacancy rate of 1.3 per cent. As well, the average monthly rents for standard spaces varied between \$1,209 in Jonquière and \$1,526 in Chicoutimi. Lastly, the capture rate in the CMA reached 19.2 per cent, a level close to the provincial average of 18.6 per cent.

# **Methodology**

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation conducts the Seniors' Housing Survey in February and March. This annual survey became national in scope in 2009, covering all centres in each of the ten provinces. Both private and non-profit residences are included in the survey universe.

To be eligible for inclusion in the survey results, a residence must:

- ✓ have at least one unit that is not subsidized;
- √ have been in operation for at least one year (for example, it must have started operation before January 2012 to be included in the 2013 survey);
- √ have at least 10 rental units (in Quebec, Ontario and the Prairies) or 5 rental units (in the Atlantic provinces and B.C.);
- ✓ offer an on-site meal plan;
- √ not mandate high levels of health care (defined as 1.5 hours or more of care per day) to all of its residents; nursing homes and long-term care homes are examples of residences that were not included in the survey;
- ✓ offer rental units; life lease units and owner-occupied units are excluded from this survey; and
- √ have at least 50 per cent of its residents who are 65 years of age or older.

The Seniors' Housing Survey is a census and not a sample survey; therefore, all seniors' residences in Canada meeting these criteria are to be part of this survey. The survey universe in Quebec may include private residences that do not meet the conditions for obtaining a certificate of compliance.

Survey data were obtained through a combination of telephone interviews and fax and e-mail responses. Information was obtained from the residence owner, manager or administrator. Survey results reflect market conditions at the time of the survey. Survey results have been weighted to adjust for non-responses, in order to ensure that they are reflective of the universe. The level of statistical reliability is noted in the data tables. For more information on the reliability of the data, please click <a href="here">here</a>.

All statistics published, excluding information on new market supply, include only those residences that have been in operation for at least one year.

# **Definitions**

**Space:** A space is a residential area that is rented out. Examples of spaces include one half of a semi-private unit, a private or bachelor unit, a one-bedroom unit and a two-bedroom unit. In most cases, a space is the same as a unit. The exception is the case where a unit has been divided to rent to multiple residents. Semi-private and ward units are an example of this. Unless otherwise indicated, data for spaces are for all unit types.

**Standard space:** A space where the resident does not receive high-level care (that is, the resident receives less than 1.5 hours of care per day) or is not required to pay an extra amount to receive high-level care. Regional terms for this type of space may vary across the country.

**Heavy care space:** A space where the resident is paying an extra amount to receive high-level care (1.5 hours or more of care per day). Examples of conditions that could require high-level care include Alzheimer's, dementia and reduced mobility.

**Respite space:** A space used to provide temporary accommodation for a senior who normally lives in another place and not at the residence.

**Non-market or subsidy space:** A space where the rent received for the unit is less than market rent or where the resident occupying the unit is subsidized.

**Rent:** The actual amount a resident pays per month for his or her accommodation space and all mandatory services. For vacant spaces, the rent is the amount the owner is asking for the space.

**Vacancy:** A space is considered vacant if, at the time of the survey, it is physically unoccupied and available for immediate rental.

**Capture rate:** The main age group living in seniors' residences are persons aged 75 years and older. Capture rate in a centre is the ratio of the total number of residents living in the survey universe divided by its estimated 75+ population, expressed as a percentage.
