## Highway Sufferance Warehouse Closure (Prince Rupert, British Columbia)

1. The purpose of this notice is to advise that:

(*a*) Effective April 10, 2015, the company located at 1600 Prince Rupert Blvd., Prince Rupert, British Columbia will be surrendering their "BW" type highway sufferance warehouse licence.

(b) The Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) is advertising for a new highway sufferance warehouse in this area.

2. The CBSA is inviting applications for a licence to operate a public "BW" type highway sufferance warehouse under the authority of the Prince Rupert CBSA office.

3. The successful applicant must provide a warehouse facility that meets the requirements of the <u>*Customs*</u> <u>*Sufferance Warehouses Regulations*</u> and operate the facility as a public sufferance warehouse to store in-bond goods.

4. Interested parties may refer to <u>Memorandum D4-1-4</u>, *Customs Sufferance Warehouses*, and should apply by submitting Form <u>E400B</u>, *Application for Licence to Operate a Customs Highway Sufferance Warehouse* to the CBSA.
