### **1.2 Human Health Risk Assessment for Federal Contaminated Sites**

“...When characterizing the risks posed by exposure to non-carcinogenic substances, British Columbia accepts a hazard quotient (HQ) of 1.0 (exposure  $\leq$  TRV), whereas Alberta and Ontario target 0.2 (exposure  $\leq$  1/5th TRV). Quebec accepts a HQ of 1.0, requiring however that background exposure is included in the calculation (MSSS, 2002).”

**The sentences above are no longer accurate. The text should read as follows:**

Provinces vary in their approach to the characterization of risks from exposures to non-carcinogenic substances.
