POPULATION ESTIMATES BY MARITAL STATUS, AGE AND SEX,
FOR CANADA AND PROVINCES, 1957

ESTIMATIONS DE LA POPULATION SUIVANT L'ÉTAT MATRIMONIAL,
L'ÂGE ET LE SEXE, CANADA ET PROVINCES, 1957

This report provides estimates of the population by marital status, age and sex, for Canada and the provinces for 1957, with comparative data for the 1951 and 1956 Censuses.

The estimated total population of Canada on June 1, 1957 was 16,558,000 of whom 11,126,900 or 67.2 p.c. were 15 years of age and over. The estimated total of males 15 years of age and over was 5,627,200, of whom 1,733,300 or 30.8 p.c. were single, 3,683,900 or 65.5 p.c. were married, and 210,000 or 3.7 p.c. were widowed or divorced. The estimated total of females, 15 years of age and over, was 5,499,700 of whom 1,289,100 or 23.4 p.c. were single, 3,655,500 or 66.5 p.c. were married, and 555,100 or 10.1 p.c. were widowed or divorced.

The rise in the percentage married since 1951 was most marked in the age group 15-24 years, where the percentage increased from 13.3 in 1951 to 16.9 in 1957 for males and from 30.1 in 1951 to 34.1 in 1957 for females. Another interesting fact revealed by these figures relates to the relative degree of widowhood among males and females. There were an estimated 555,100 widowed and including a small number of divorced women in Canada in 1957 as compared with 210,000 men in this category. This marital group of women has increased by 80,000 or 16.8 p.c. since 1951 as compared with an 11,000 increase or 5.5 p.c. among men.

Statement of Procedure

Using the 1956 Census figures on marital status by age and sex as a base, vital statistics data on births by sex, marriages and deaths by marital status, age and sex, and on dissolutions of marriages, as well as immigration statistics by marital status, age and sex, for the period June 1, 1956 to June 1, 1957, were applied to the 1956 Census figures to obtain estimates of the population by marital status, age and sex, for 1957. Allowance has also been made for the marital status, age and sex composition of the estimated number of emigrants and inter-provincial migrants over this period. Finally the age totals in Table 1 were adjusted to correspond with the official population estimates by age and sex for 1957 published in the 1957 Supplement to D.B.S. Reference Paper No. 40.

Le présent rapport contient, pour le Canada et les provinces, des estimations de la population suivant l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe en 1957, de même que les chiffres comparatifs des recensements de 1951 et 1956.

La population estimative totale du Canada le 1^{er} juin 1957 était de 16,558,000 habitants dont 11,126,900 ou 67.2 étaient âgés de 15 ans et plus. Le total estimatif des personnes de sexe masculin âgées de 15 ans et plus était de 5,627,200 dont 1,733,300 ou 30.8 p. 100 étaient célibataires, 3,683,900 ou 65.5 p. 100, mariés et 210,000 ou 3.7 p. 100, veufs ou divorcés. Le total estimatif des personnes de sexe féminin âgées de 15 ans et plus était de 5,499,700 dont 1,289,100 ou 23.4 p. 100 étaient célibataires, 3,655,500 ou 66.5 p. 100, mariées, et 555,100 ou 10.1 p. 100, veuves ou divorcées.

La montée procentuelle des personnes mariées depuis 1951 a été très marquée dans le groupe d'âge de 15-24 ans. Parti de 13.3 p. 100 en 1951, le pourcentage chez les hommes s'est élevé à 16.9 en 1957; chez les femmes il s'est élevé de 30.1 en 1951 à 34.1 en 1957. Ces chiffres révèlent, en outre, un détail intéressant quant au degré relatif de veuvage parmi les hommes et les femmes. Le nombre estimatif de veuves, y compris un petit nombre de divorcées au Canada en 1957, était de 555,100 au regard de 210,000 veufs. Ce groupe matrimonial de femmes s'est accru de 80,000 ou 16.8 p. 100 depuis 1951 au regard d'une augmentation de 11,000 ou 5.5 p. 100 chez les hommes.

Exposé de la méthode

Les chiffres du recensement de 1956 sur l'état matrimonial suivant l'âge et le sexe servant de base, les données de l'état civil sur les naissances suivant le sexe, sur les mariages et les décès suivant l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe et sur les dissolutions de mariages, aussi bien que la statistique de l'émigration suivant l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe pour la période écoulée entre le 1^{er} juin 1956 et le 1^{er} juin 1957 ont été appliqués aux chiffres du recensement de 1956, ce qui a donné, pour 1957, les estimations de la population suivant l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe. Il a été aussi tenu compte de la composition, suivant l'état matrimonial, l'âge et le sexe, du nombre estimatif des émigrants et des transmigrants interprovinciaux durant la période. Finalement, les chiffres du tableau I quant à l'âge ont été rectifiés afin qu'ils correspondent aux estimations officielles de la population suivant l'âge et le sexe pour 1957 publiées dans le Supplément de 1957 au Document de référence n° 40 du B.F.S.
