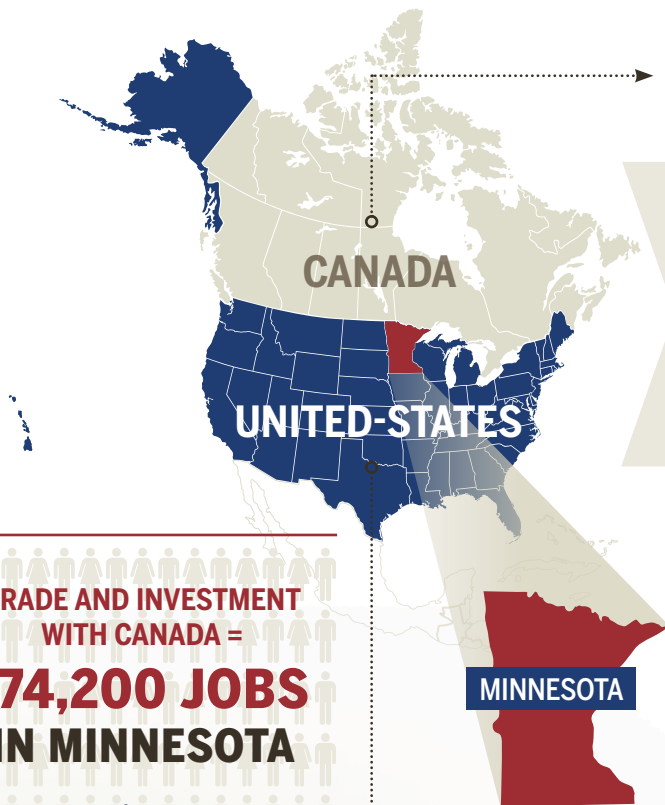

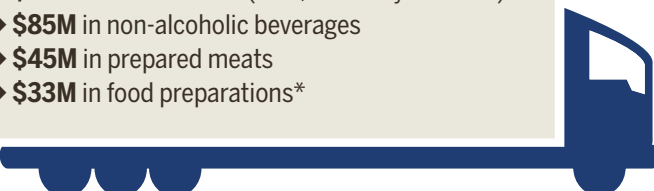

**AGRICULTURAL TRADE =
\$1.3 BILLION IN 2016**

MINNESOTA EXPORTED \$725 MILLION TO CANADA, INCLUDING:

- \$126M in ethanol
- \$100M in animal feed (incl. \$25M in soybean meal)
- \$85M in non-alcoholic beverages
- \$45M in prepared meats
- \$33M in food preparations*



MINNESOTA IMPORTED \$604 MILLION FROM CANADA, INCLUDING:

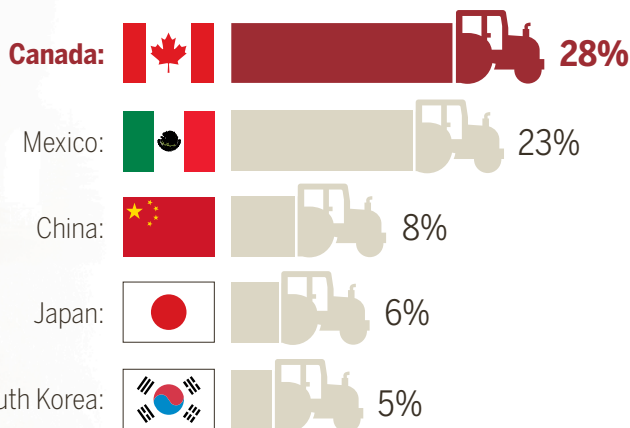
- \$152M in live animals (incl. \$102M in live cattle)
- \$70M in canola seeds
- \$65M in wheat
- \$48M in oats
- \$28M in fats and oils

* The category "food preparations" includes products such as tea substitutes, vegetable preparations, flavoring extracts, powders and essences, milk or cream substitutes, jelly powders, and juices from concentrate.
