SILVER, LEAD AND ZINC PRODUCTION

Silver - Output in Canada of primary silver in all forms amounted to 2,823,241 fine ounces in July 1962, compared with 2,670,151 fine ounces in the previous month and with 2,393,725 fine ounces in July 1961.
