GRINDING BALLS, 1947

Production of grinding balls in Canada totalled 25,096 short tons in 1947 compared with 23,908 tons in 1946 and 21,946 tons in 1945. The output in 1947 included 8,695 tons of cast iron balls and 16,401 tons of cast and forged steel balls.
