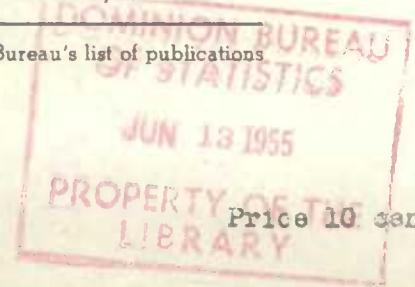

GRINDING BALLS - 1953 and 1954

Production of grinding balls in Canada totalled 29,041 net tons in 1954 compared with 27,978 net tons in 1953. The 1954 output included 14,130 net tons of cast iron and cast steel balls and 13,800 net tons of forged steel balls.
