CANADIAN PRODUCTION

1) Spun Yarn, Pure Polyamide (Nylon)

There are at least nine manufacturers of pure polyamide (nylon) spun yarn in Canada. In 1985, Statistics Canada reports that shipments from establishments amounted to 3 800 tonnes for a value of \$24.6 million (latest year for which information is available).

2) Filament Yarn, Stretch and Other Textured Polyamide (Nylon)

There are at least twelve manufacturers of polyamide (nylon) filament yarn, stretch and other. In 1985, Statistics Canada reports that shipments amounted to 36 300 tonnes for a value of \$171.5 million.

CANADIAN EXPORTS

Statistics Canada reports that exports of nylon yarn amounted to 6 200 tonnes for a value of \$26.6 million during 1987. The United States accounted for 92 per cent of the quantity and value of exports. Effective January 1, 1988 Statistics Canada reports domestic exports under the Harmonized System as follows:

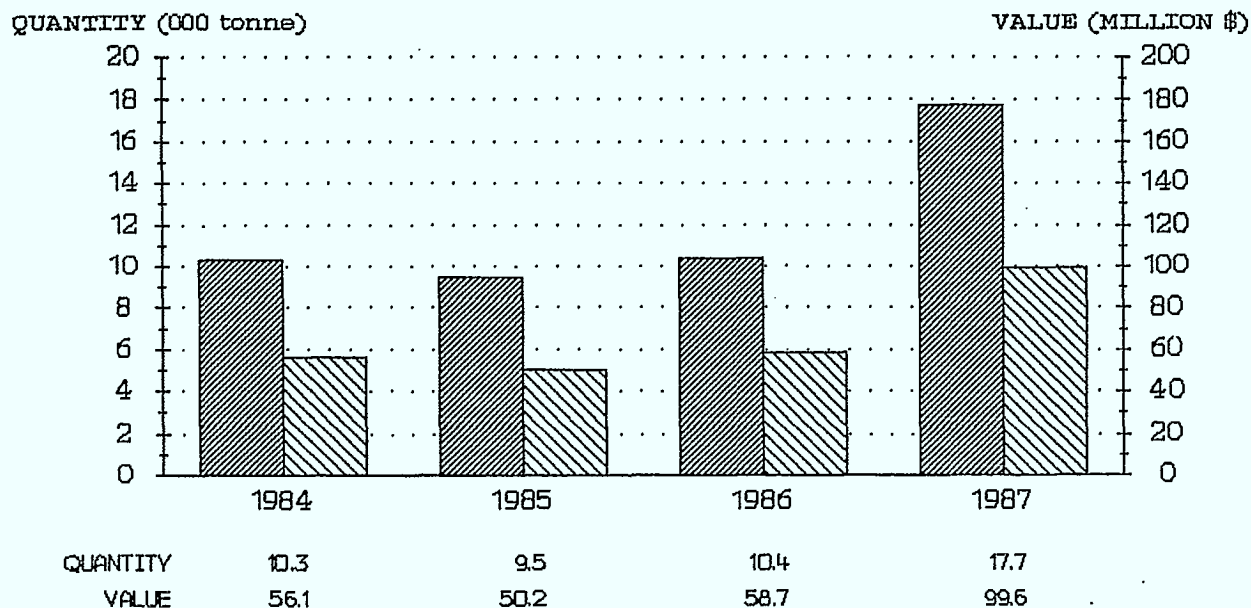

MARKET SUMMARY

Overall demand for all nylon filament yarn reached a record high of 75 200 tonnes in 1987, up from a level of 60 400 tonnes in 1986. Nylon carpet yarn is by far the largest market segment with over 60 per cent of the total market and accounted for close to 70 per cent of the increase in demand in 1987 over 1986. Nylon yarn for apparel, tire, and industrial use are the other major market elements. In 1987, exports of all nylon filament yarn represented some 11 per cent of total shipments.

Valuation

Imports are generally recorded at the values established for customs duty purposes according to the provisions of the Customs Act. Customs values are identical to selling prices for most transactions between non-affiliated companies, but customs values exceed selling prices for many transactions between affiliated companies. All values are reported in Canadian dollars and do not include duty.

Average Growth Rate

Growth rates are calculated on the basis of annual compounding.

Rounding

Figures may not add due to rounding.

Identification of Foreign Exporting Companies

The names of the foreign exporting companies are as captured on the computer system and may not be the full legal corporate name. A foreign company may appear in the source several different ways. Attempts are made to consolidate all various entries into one company. For this reason, the value associated with any given company is deemed to be the minimum value.
