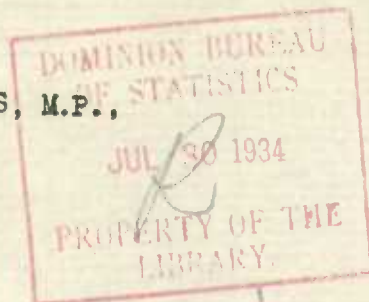

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INVESTORS' INDEX NUMBERS OF SECURITY PRICES  
(1926-100)

The "Investors'" weighted index numbers of security prices, computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base 1926=100, were as follows for the week ending July 26th.

The "Investors'" index for all groups of common stocks combined was 85.6 for the week ending July 26th, as compared with 91.0 for the previous week.

The "Investors'" index of industrial common stocks was 115.1 for the week ending July 26th, as compared with 123.3 for the previous week.

The "Investors'" index of domestic utility common stocks was 49.7 for the week ending July 26th, as compared with 52.1 for the previous week.

The "Investors'" index of common stocks of companies located abroad in which Canadians are heavily interested was 93.6 for the week ending July 26th, as compared with 99.1 for the previous week.
