WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 17 MINING STOCKS 1926 - 100 The weighted index numbers of seventeen mining stocks computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics on the base of 1926 = 100 was 127.6 for the week ending June 14th as compared with 121.8 for the week ending June 7th. Gold copper stocks represented by Moranda and Amulet rose from 176.3 to 194.8. Eleven gold stocks rose from 112.4 to 115.2. Four silver and miscellaneous stocks fell from 93.2 to 91.5. Among the gold stocks the average weekly prices behaved as follows:Coniaurum rose from \$4.51 to \$4.65. Hollinger from \$14.06 to \$14.60, Kirkland
Lake from \$1.82 to \$1.88, Lake Shore from \$23.04 to \$24.36, Teck-Hughes from
\$10.30 to \$11.01 and Wright-Hargreaves from \$4.24 to \$4.27. Dome fell from \$9.20 to \$8.61, McIntyre from \$26.70 to \$26.59 and Sylvanite from \$3.13 to \$3.10. Average prices were higher for both of the gold-copper stocks. Amulet rose from \$3.94 to \$4.07 and Noranda from \$30.43 to \$33.99. In the silver and miscellaneous group the average price of Nipissing fell from \$4.07 to \$4.01, Coniagas from \$4.90 to \$4.84 and Mining Corporation from \$3.44 to \$3.35. 18/6/28.DAK.
