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## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926=100)

Gains in prices of base metals issues cverbalanced losses for gold stocks, and as a result the general index of mining stocks showed a alight advance from 116.0 for the week of October 3 to 116.3 for the week of October 10. For the corresponding week in 1934, this index was 137.0.

A downward movement was maintained by the gold group, the index being 102.6 for the week of October 10, as compared with 104.1 for the preceding week. For the week ending October 11, last year the index registered was 136.2.

A pronounced advance was noticed in base metals, due to substantial individual gains for each of the stocks included in this group. Accordingly the index mounted from 164.5 for the week of October 3 to 171.8 for the week of October 10. The index for the comparative week in 1934 was 145.7.
