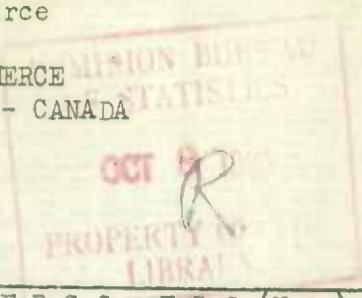

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WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS
(1926=100)

For the third consecutive week, the general index of mining stocks moved lower, registering 116.0 for the week of October 3, as compared with 117.6 for the preceding week and 135.6 for the corresponding week in 1934.

In the latter part of the week, daily quotations of gold issues declined, causing the index of nineteen gold stocks to drop from 106.8 for the week of September 26, to 104.1 for the week of October 3. The index for the comparative week in 1934 was 134.1.

Due to the influence of higher prices for Hudson Bay and Noranda, the base metals index attained the level of 144.5 for the week of October 3, the maximum reached since the 3rd week of June, 1934. For the week of September 26, this index was 162.1, and 147.2 was recorded for the week of October 4, 1934.

Listed below is a comparative table of prices as compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics, giving the figures for the weeks October 3, September 26, 1935, and October 4, 1934.
