(1926=100)

The gradual increase apparent in the general price index of mining issues continued throughout the week ending November 28, the index being 129.9, as compared with 126.6 for the preceding week. It was 120.7 for the week of November 29, 1934.

Golds moved steadily higher with Dome, Lake Shore and McIntyre leading, the index for this group being 115.6 for the week of November 28, and 112.5 for the week of November 21. The comparative index for the same week last year was 120.2.

Prices of base metals continued steadily upward, the index reaching 188.6, an advance of over sixty points on the corresponding index for the same interval in 1934. For the week of November 21, this index was 184.4.

Following is a table of prices, as compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics comparing quotations for the week of November 28, 1935, with those of the previous week and also with the figures of November 29, 1934.
