## WEIGHTED INDEX NUMBERS OF 23 MINING STOCKS (1926-100)

A slight gain of 0.04 points was registered for the general index of 23 mining stocks, which placed this index at 117.8 for the week ending August 1st, as compared with 117.4 for the previous week. For the corresponding week last year this index Was 132.2.

After several weeks of constant decline, the index of nineteen gold issues showed a minor advance, rising from 109.1 for the week ending July 25 to 109.2 for the following week. This index for the same week in 1934 was 129.2.

The upward movement was maintained in the Base Metals stocks. This index mounted from 153.4 for the week of July 25 to 154.8 for the week ending August 1st. For this group, the index of 149.6 was recorded for the week ending August 2nd, 1934.

A table of prices as computed by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics is given below showing the quotations for the weeks of August 1st, July 25th, 1935 and August 2, 1934.
