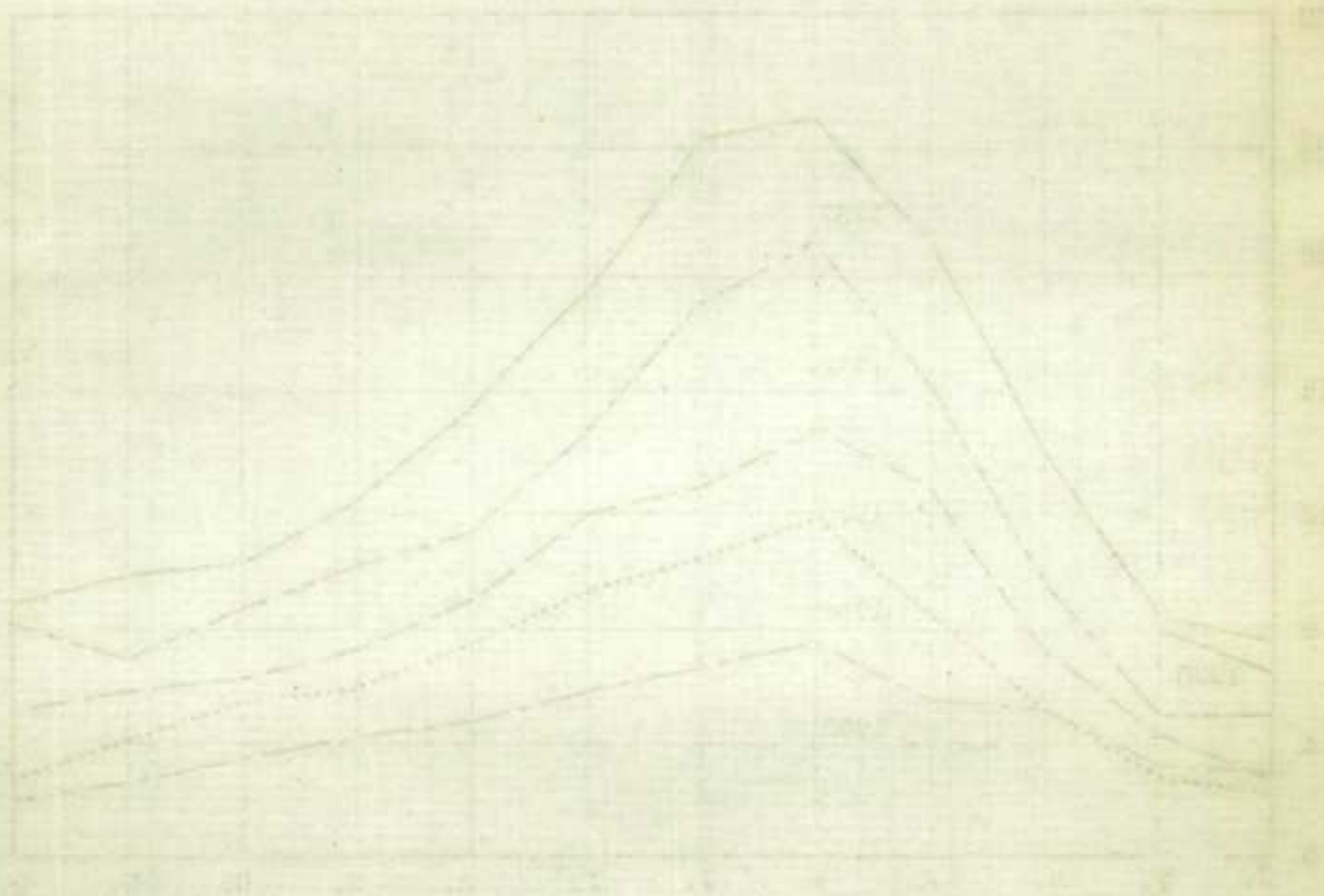
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Graph showing the progress of the health services in West Bengal during the year 1954-55.
