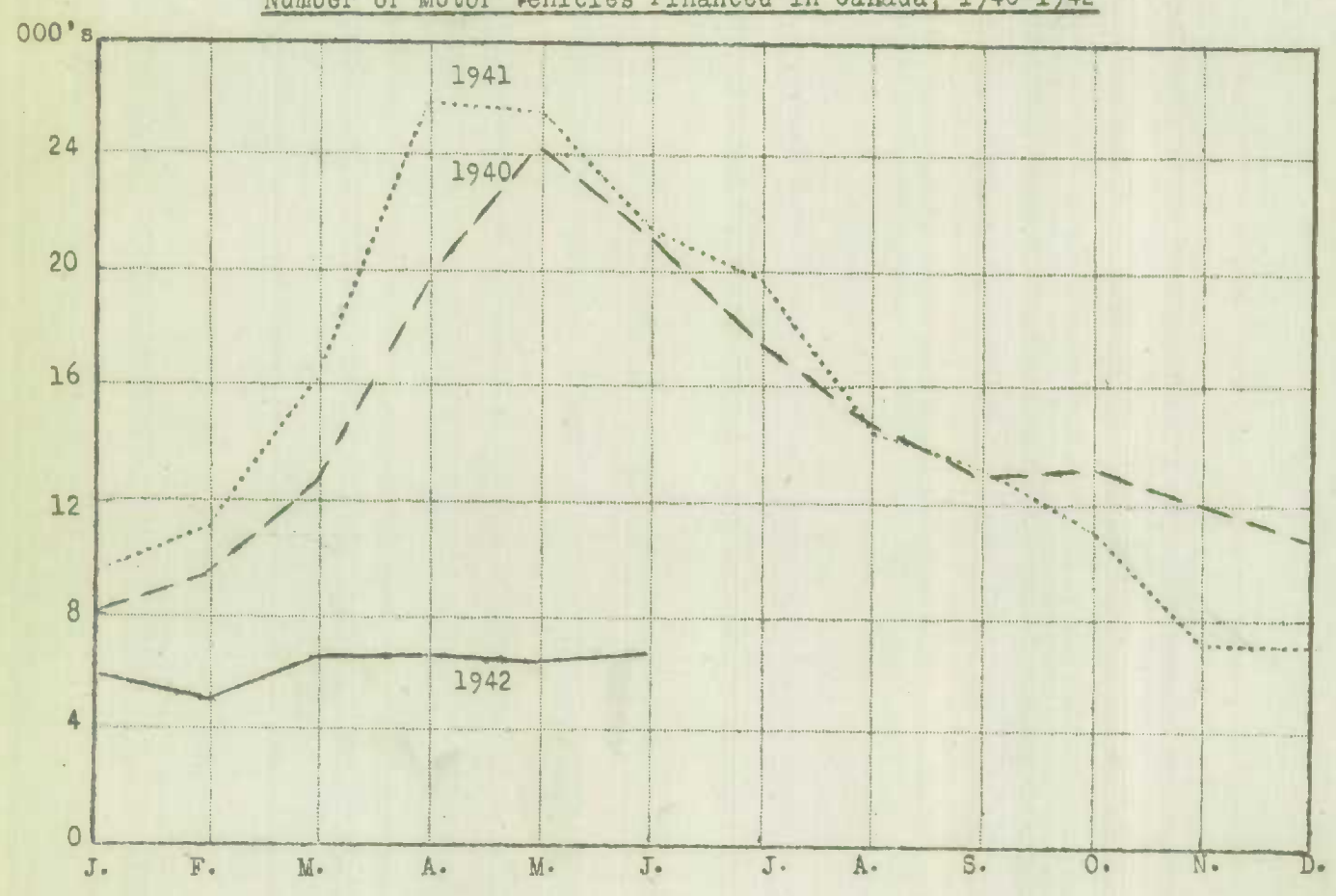
MONTHLY FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, JUNE, 1942

Financing of new and used motor vehicles in Canada in June, 1942, totalled 6,712 with a financed value of \$2,287,731, down 69 per cent in number and 77 per cent in amount of financing from the 21,396 vehicles financed to the extent of \$9,798,562 in June a year ago. During the first half of the current year sales of 36,798 vehicles have been financed for an amount of \$14,928,681, decreases of 66 per cent in number and 71 per cent in amount of financing being recorded below the 109,534 units financed for \$51,900,736 in the corresponding period of 1941.

New vehicle financing declined 91 per cent in number and 90 per cent in amount of financing below June of last year, the 383 units financed for \$367,163 in the month under review comparing with 4,351 new vehicles financed for \$3,751,141 in June, 1941. Declines in Quebec and the Maritime Provinces amounted to 85 and 95 per cent respectively, while decreases in other regions held closely to the average reduction of 92 per cent.

Declines of 63 per cent in number and 68 per cent in amount of financing below June of last year occurred in the used vehicle field. There were 6,329 transactions involving \$1,920,568 in June this year, as compared with 17,045 units with a financed value of \$6,047,421 in the same month of 1941. The following declines occurred in various regions of the country: 57 per cent in British Columbia, 59 per cent in Alberta, 61 per cent in Ontario, 65 per cent in Quebec and in combined figures for Manitoba and Saskatchewan, and 79 per cent in the Maritime Provinces.

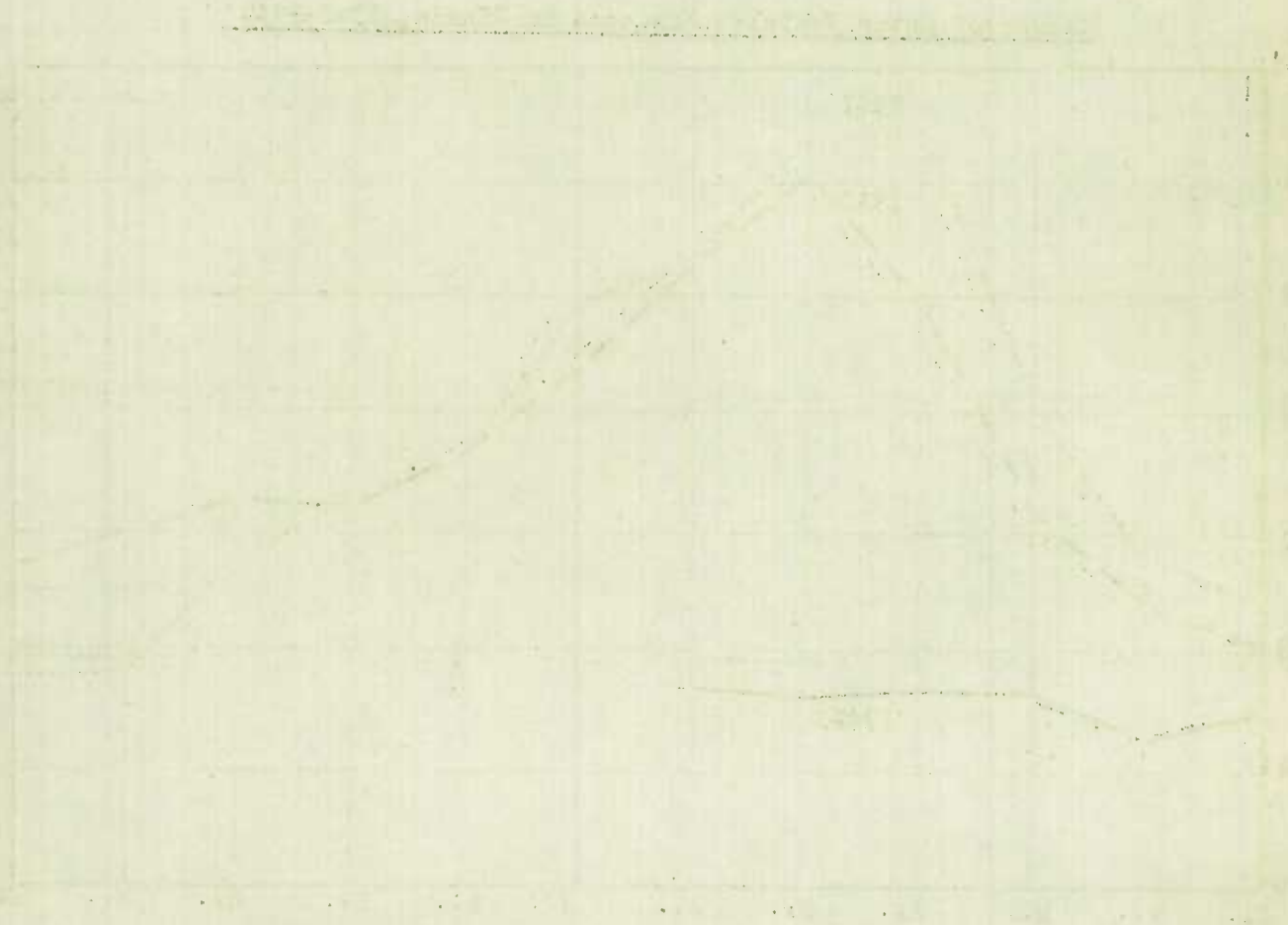
