STATISTICS OF AUTOMOBILE FINANCING

The figures for automobile financing compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics while showing a seasonal drop in June as compared with May of this year, again indicates a falling off in financing as compared with the corresponding month (June) in 1929. The per cent of change is -35.5.

The total number of cars financed was 13,648 in June 1930, 19,559 in May 1930 and 19,620 in June 1929, and the amount of financing was \$6,233,964 in June 1930, \$9,581,643 in May 1930, and \$9,659,296 in June 1929.

New cars financed were 5,957 in June 1930, 8,559 in May 1930 and 8,825 in June 1929, while used cars financed were 7,691 in June 1930, 11,000 in May 1930 and 10,795 in June 1929.

Values of new cars financed were \$3,683,372 in June 1930, \$4,976,598 in May 1930 and \$5,944,651 in June 1929. Values in used cars financed were \$2,550,592 in June 1930, \$4,605,045 in May 1930 and \$3,714,645 in June 1929.
