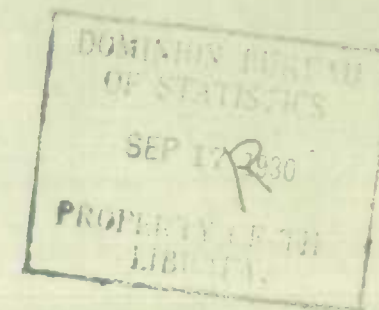

STATISTICS OF AUTOMOBILE FINANCING

The figures for automobile financing compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics shows a drop in July as compared with June of this year, and also indicates a falling off in financing as compared with the corresponding month (July) in 1929. The per cent of change is -39.4.

The total number of cars financed was 12,121 in July 1930, 16,496 in June 1930 and 17,847 in July 1929, and the amount of financing was \$5,849,168 in July 1930, \$7,894,616 in June 1930, and \$9,646,594 in July 1929.

New cars financed were 4,671 in July 1930, 7,020 in June 1930 and 7,824 in July 1929, while used cars financed were 7,450 in July 1930, 9,476 in June 1930 and 10,023 in July 1929.

Values of new cars financed were \$2,617,420 in July 1930, \$4,605,077 in June 1930 and \$5,179,063 in July 1929. Values in used cars financed were \$3,231,748 in July 1930, \$3,289,539 in June 1930 and \$4,467,531 in July 1929.
