STATISTICS OF AUTOMOBILE FINANCING IN CANADA  
 JANUARY, 1931, TO AUGUST, 1933.

The number of retail sales of new and used automobiles, trucks and buses financed in Canada during August, 1933, and the amount involved in financing these sales have been compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics.

The figures for August, 1933, show a decrease in the total amount of financing as compared with July, 1933, and indicate a drop of 17.2% as compared with August, 1932.

The total number of vehicles financed was 4,782 in August, 1933, 5,852 in July, 1933, and 6,065 in August, 1932; and the amount of financing was \$1,808,440 in August, 1933, \$2,137,692 in July, 1933, and \$2,184,701 in August, 1932.

New vehicles financed were 1,386 in August, 1933, 1,775 in July, 1933, and 1,709 in August, 1932, while used vehicles numbered 3,396 in August, 1933, 4,077 in July, 1933, and 4,356 in August, 1932.

The amount of financing for new vehicles was \$906,611 in August, 1933, \$1,145,803 in July, 1933, and \$1,023,137 in August, 1932; and the total for used vehicles was \$901,829 in August, 1933, \$991,889 in July, 1933, and \$1,161,564 in August, 1932.
