FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, DECEMBER, 1936

A striking advance in motor vehicle financing occurred during December last as compared with a year ago. The total for new and used vehicles was 8,219, making a 58 per cent increase over the 5,206 shown for December, 1935, and a gain of 192 per cent over the December, 1934, total of 2,818.

The downward trend from November usually shown by new vehicles was reversed during December for the second year in succession. This is due, of course, to the earlier introduction of new models. There were 3,311 new vehicles financed for \$2.2 millions during December as against 1,996 for \$1.4 millions during November. The 1935 aggregates were 1,864 vehicles at \$1.3 millions and 1,787 at \$1.2 millions for December and November respectively.

While used vehicles show a gain over December, 1935, of 47 per cent in number and 40 per cent in amount, it is interesting to note that improvement over November is shown for the first time. There were 4,908 used vehicles financed to the extent of \$1.3 millions during the month under review, 3,342 for \$0.9 millions during the same month last year, and 4,885 for \$1.3 millions during November, 1936.

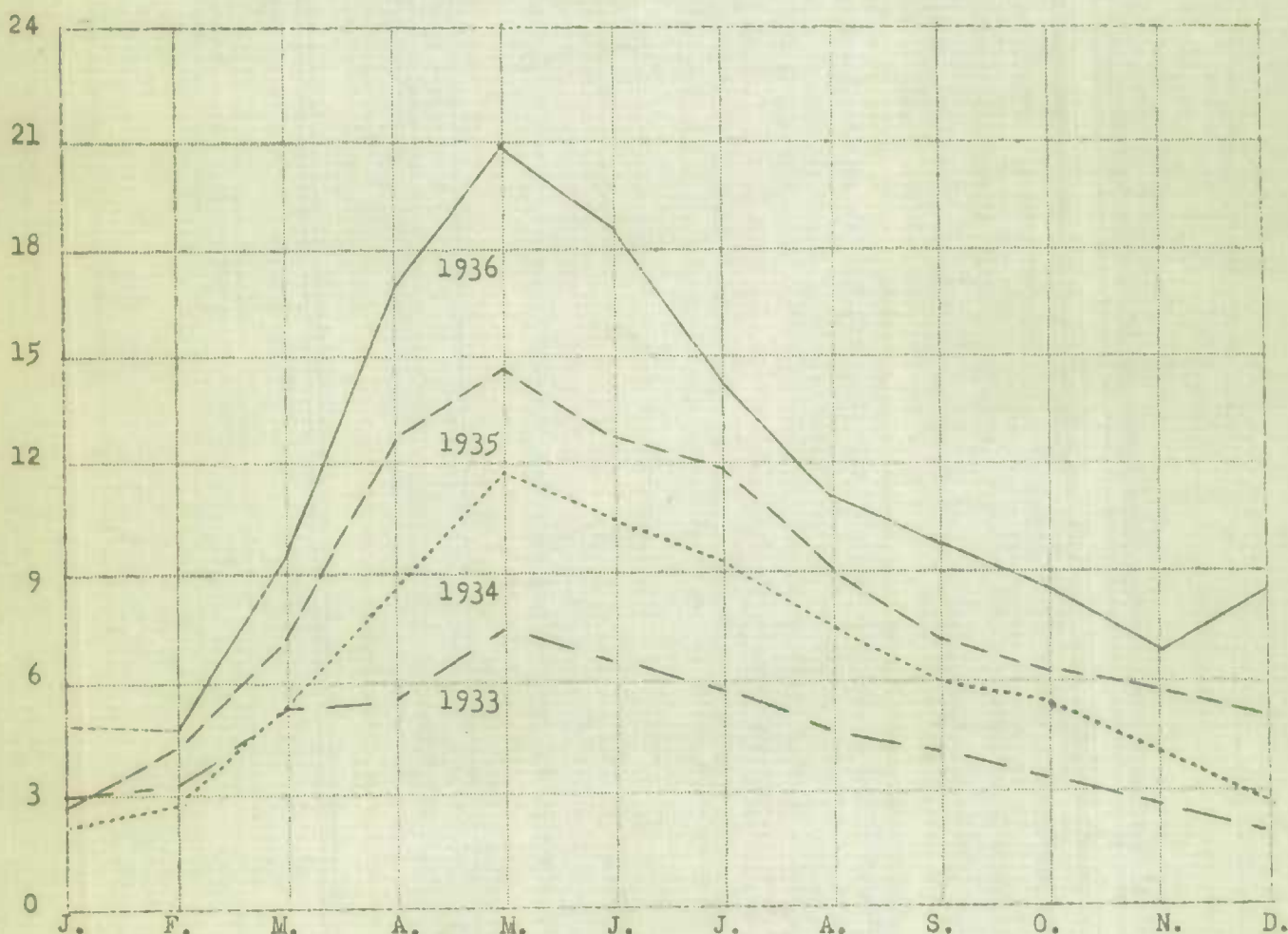
All provinces reported increases for new vehicles during December compared with November. A mixed trend was shown for used vehicles, the Maritimes, Quebec and Manitoba and Saskatchewan recorded declines from November, while Ontario, Alberta and British Columbia showed unusual improvement.

The preliminary total of new and used vehicles financed during 1936 was 134,862, of which 42,560 or 32 per cent were new vehicles and 92,302 or 68 per cent were used vehicles. The aggregate amount of financing for new vehicles was \$29,726,841 or \$698 per vehicle, while the corresponding total for used vehicles was \$24,482,159 or \$265 per vehicle.

Note: All 1936 data are preliminary, and revised figures will be shown in an annual report which will be published shortly.

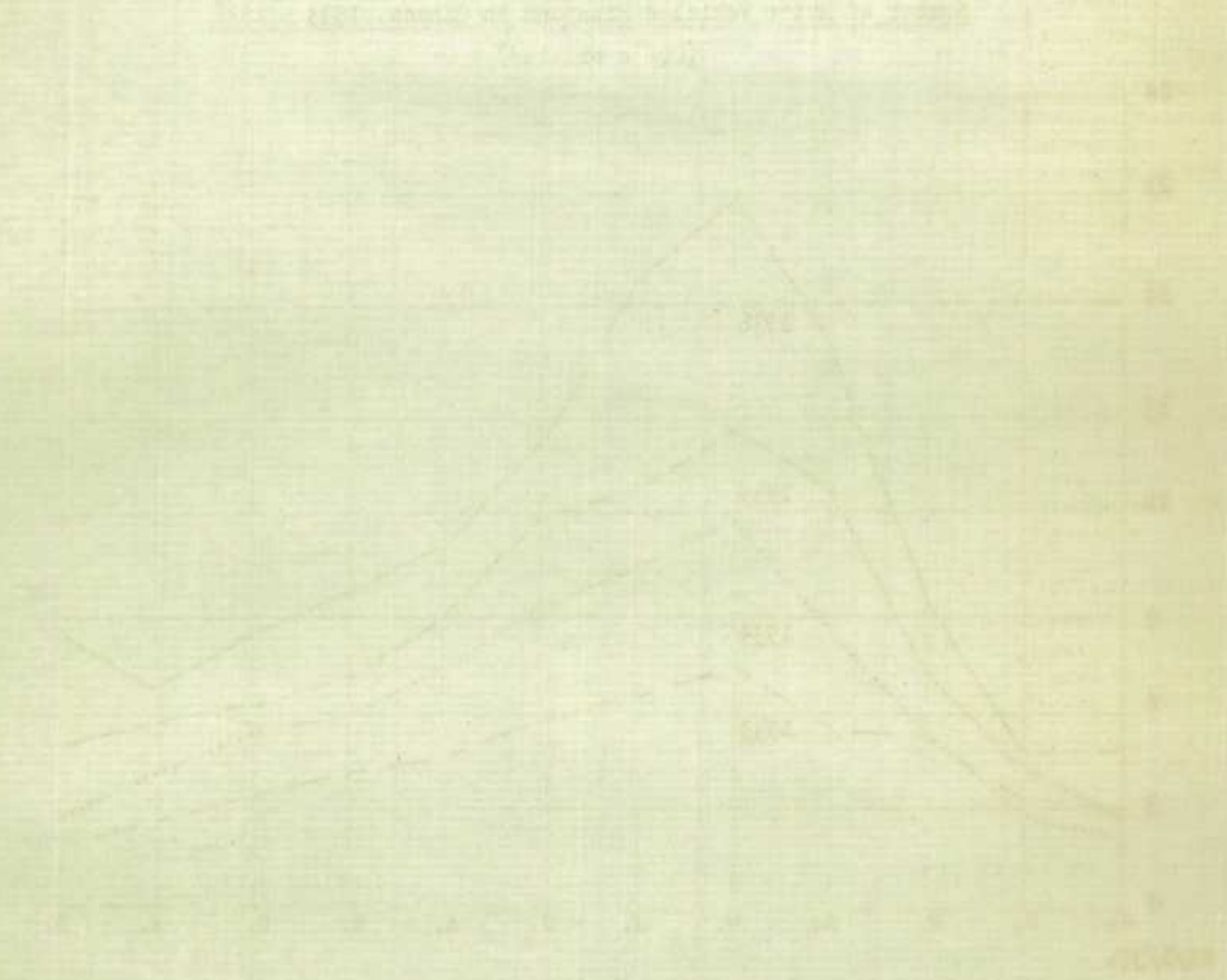
