FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, JUNE, 1936.

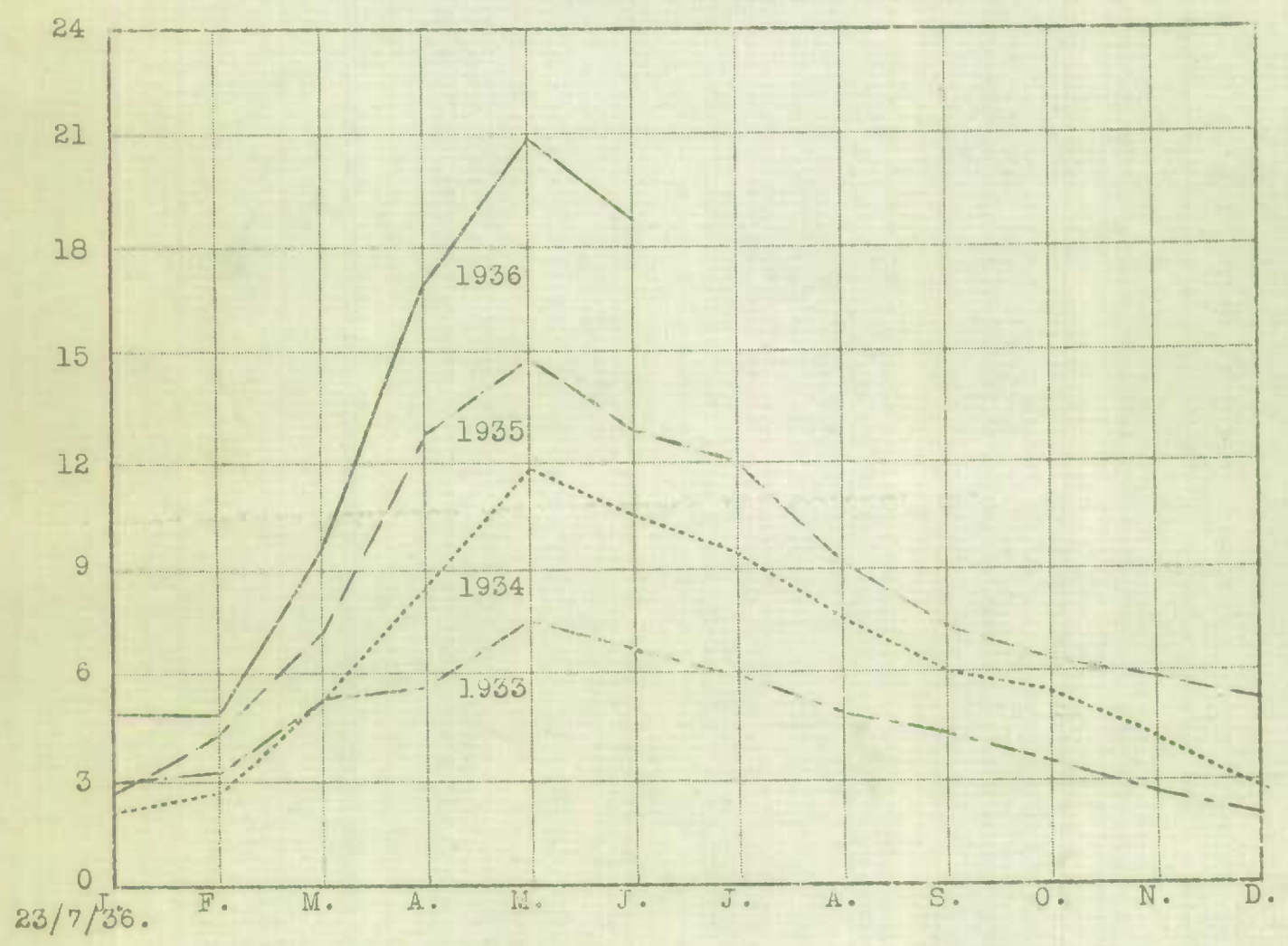
The upward trend of motor vehicle financing in Canada was continued in June. There were 18,653 vehicles financed to the extent of \$7,343,729, a gain of 45 per cent in number and 48 per cent in dollar volume over June last year. The June figures show a seasonal decline from the peak month, May, when 20,849 vehicles were financed for \$8,566,448.

The six-month totals likewise reflect marked increases over corresponding figures for 1935. From January to June, 1936, 75,666 vehicles were financed for \$30,906,522 as compared with 54,469 vehicles at \$22,605,172 for last year.

The number of new vehicles financed in Canada in June was 5,551, compared with 3,862 a year ago, a gain of 43 per cent. The amount was \$3,954,222, an increase of 48 per cent. Provincial distribution of the 5,551 new vehicles follows: Ontario, 2,518 or 46 per cent; Quebec, 941 or 17 per cent; Manitoba and Saskatchewan, 741 or 13 per cent; Alberta, 542 or 10 per cent; British Columbia, 405 or 7 per cent, and the Maritimes, 404 or 7 per cent.

Used vehicles financed during June numbered 13,102, a gain of 46 per cent over June, 1935, while the corresponding amount of financing \$3,389,507 showed a gain of 48 per cent over last year. Of the Dominion total, 50 per cent, or 6,487 used vehicles were financed in Ontario; 16 per cent or 2,116 in Quebec; 10 per cent or 1,381 in Manitoba and Saskatchewan; 9 per cent or 1,154 in Alberta; 8 per cent or 1,023 in British Columbia, and 7 per cent or 941 in the Maritimes.
