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FINANCING OF MOTOR VEHICLE SALES IN CANADA, NOVEMBER, 1937

Motor vehicle sales financed in Canada during November totalled 9,945 compared with 6,960 for November, 1936, a gain of 42.9 per cent. Corresponding financed values were \$4,390,340 for November, 1937, and \$2,769,329 for November, 1936, or a gain of 58.5 per cent.

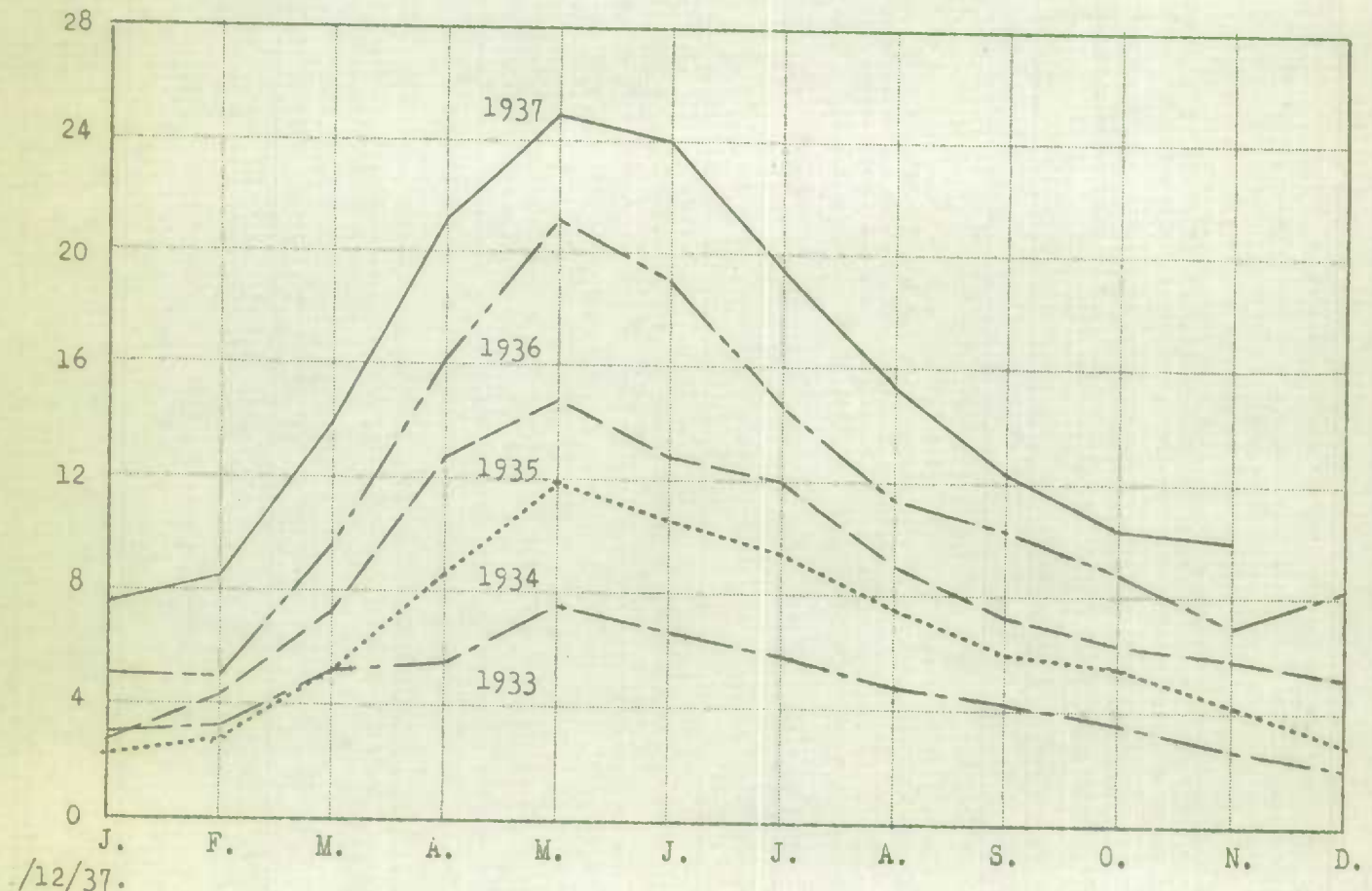
Cumulative totals indicated a 29.5 per cent advance in number and a 38.4 per cent gain in amount compared with last year. During the eleven-month period January to November, 1937, sales of 167,402 vehicles were financed for \$71,104,776, while the cumulative totals for 1936 were 129,243 vehicles at \$51,392,052.

Passenger cars financed during November numbered 3,066 at \$2,350,778, an advance of 52.2 per cent in number and 61.1 per cent in value compared with last November, when 2,015 vehicles were financed for \$1,459,643. All provinces showed increases in both number and amount. The percentage gains in number ranged from a high of 152.5 for Alberta to a low of 36.1 for Ontario. Percentage changes in value varied from 147.6 for Alberta to 43.5 for Ontario.

Used vehicles totalling 6,879 were financed for \$2,039,562 during November compared with 4,945 at \$1,309,686 last year, recording gains of 39.1 per cent in number and 55.7 per cent in value. Alberta again showed the best improvement with an 83.2 per cent advance in number and a 96.4 per cent increase in value. Smallest gains were shown for British Columbia with a 10.6 per cent advance in number and a 20.6 per cent increase in amount.

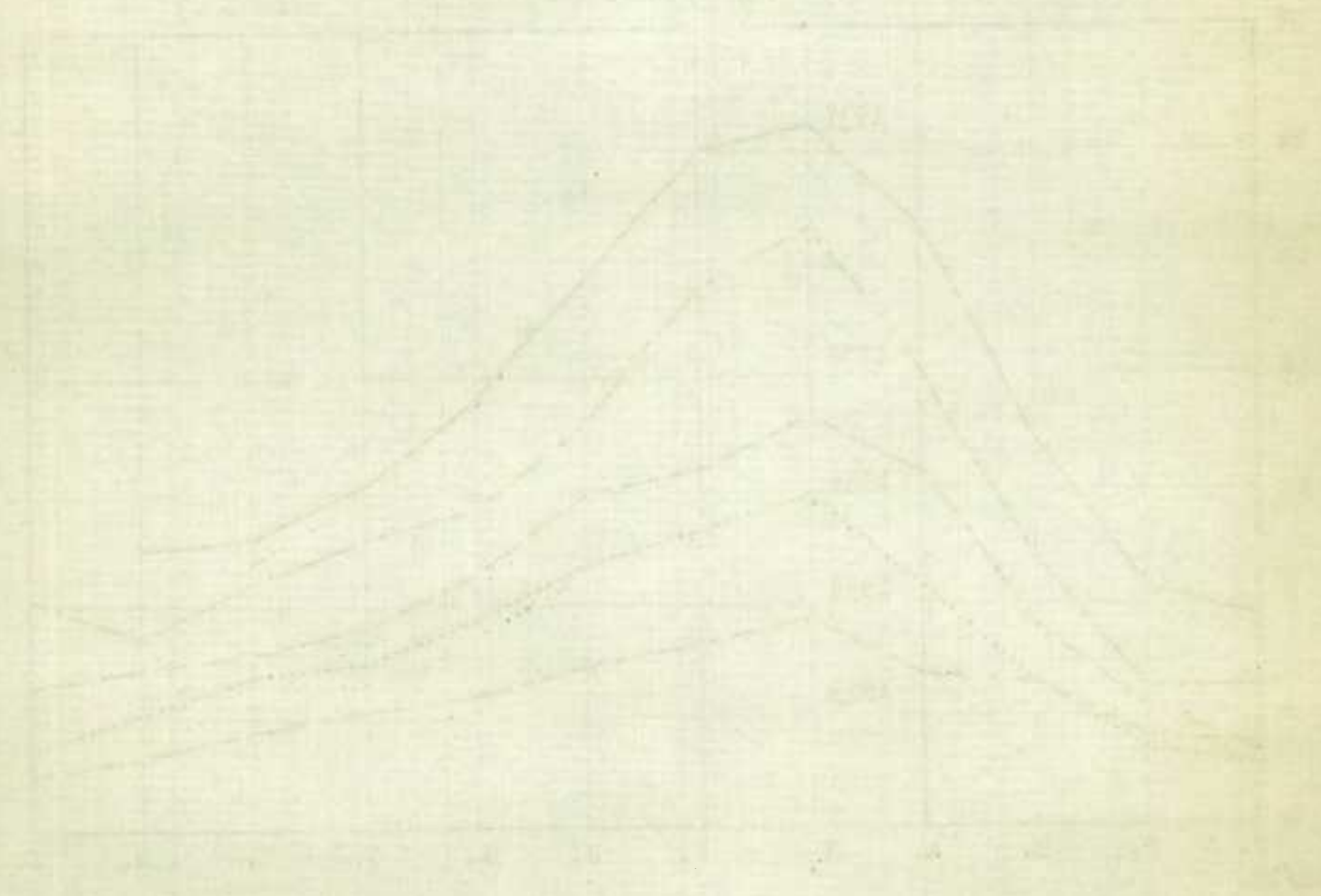
