
Stocks of frozen and chilled meat products

March 2003

Highlights

Total frozen and chilled red meat in cold storage at the opening of the first business day of March amounted to 87 823 metric tonnes, no percentage change from 87 746 tonnes in February and up 9% from 80 789 tonnes in March 2002. The graph below depicts the monthly stocks of all frozen and chilled red meat from January 1990 to March 2003.




Methodology

This bulletin presents data on stocks of frozen and chilled meat at the wholesale level obtained from a monthly census of known cold storage establishments registered with the Canadian Food Inspection Agency. Included are such facilities as meat packers, wholesale butchers, abattoirs, and central warehouses of large retail grocery stores. Data not received in time for publication for the current month are estimated through imputation until such time as actual data are available. Therefore, current month data are preliminary and subject to revision.
