Whether you are in the public or private sector, a business person, a research consultant or a student, having the right data is often critical to the success or failure of your project. Statistics Canada collects and publishes a large amount of data on all modes of transportation. For example, do you know the level of shipments of commodities last quarter? Where are the key access points to the United States and which commodities are moving through them? How can you determine market share? It will allow you to take advantage of what Statistics Canada has to offer you.

The Guide contains a description of each survey at Statistics Canada that has transportation-related information. Each survey is listed with the survey name, a person to contact, phone number and fax number, a brief description of the transportation related information in the survey, the periodicity of the survey and the publication catalogue number and name where the information can be found. 
