Highlights:

- In February 1999, the carload freight (excluding intermodal traffic) loaded by railways in Canada totalled 18.3 million metric tonnes.
- The intermodal tonnage, represented by "container-on-flat-cars" (C.O.F.C.) and "trailer-on-flat-cars" (T.O.F.C.), was 1.8 million metric tonnes.
- The five top loaded commodities were: coal (3.4 million metric tonnes), iron ores and concentrates (2.4 million metric tonnes), potash (1.3 million metric tonnes), wheat (1.1 million metric tonnes) and lumber (0.8 million metric tonnes).
- The cumulative freight loaded (excluding intermodal traffic) for the months of January and February 1999 reached 35.9 million metric tonnes.
