Highlights

Second quarter 2005 and June 2005

Canadian railways reported their strongest second quarter since 1999 between April and June this year as demand in Asia for Canadian primary goods remained strong.

Railways loaded more than 72.9 million tonnes of goods during the second quarter of 2005, up by more than half a million tonnes, or 0.8%, from the same three months last year.

Leading the list of commodities where gains in loadings occurred between the first and second quarter were cement, gasoline and aviation fuel, other non metallic minerals, coal and lumber.

Coal shipments amounted to nearly 9.1 million tonnes, up 10.2% from the same quarter last year. Lumber shipments, primarily destined for the United States, surpassed 4.3 million tonnes, up 27.6%.

Just over 7.0 million tonnes of freight arrived from the United States between April and June, either destined for or passing through Canada, up 6.7% from the same three months in 2004.

On a monthly basis, railways shipped nearly 24.7 million tonnes of goods in June, the highest volume of the last six years for June itself.

Iron ore loadings were up strongly from May following the settlement of a labour dispute which had more than 1300 employees off work. However, shipments of major commodities such as potash and coal showed some declines as is often the case in early summer.

The non-intermodal portion of freight totalled 22.4 million tonnes in June, up 1.8% from May. About 282,300 railcars were required to load all of June's non-intermodal freight.

Loadings of intermodal freight, that is, containers and trailers hauled on flat cars, amounted to 2.3 million tonnes, down 4.9% from May.

Freight coming from the United States, either destined for or passing through Canada, fell 12.4%.

On a year-over-year basis, non-intermodal tonnage was up 4.3% from June last year. Intermodal traffic rose 0.6%, while traffic received from the United States was up 4.8%.

Methodology and concepts

The *Railway Carloadings (Monthly)* publication presents essential data for timely analysis of the Rail Transport Industry and its contribution to the Canadian economy. Approximately 40 rail carriers report each month on their total intermodal and non-intermodal¹ traffic of the previous month. For non-intermodal traffic, the carriers report the number of cars and tonnes by commodity of revenue-generating freight that they have loaded in Canada. For intermodal freight, the carriers report the number of units and tonnes for containers-on-flat-cars (C.O.F.C.) and trailers-on-flat-cars (T.O.F.C.), with no commodity detail. The carriers also report the total tonnage of revenue freight received from United States connections.

The total quantity of freight carried in Canada is the sum of the non-intermodal and intermodal freight loaded and the traffic received from U.S. connections. Additional information provided includes the number of units and tonnes of C.O.F.C. and T.O.F.C received from U.S. connections and the total tonnes of cargo that the carriers received from other Canadian connections. This freight that is exchanged among Canadian based carriers is counted only once in the total quantity of freight moved as it is counted only when loaded. For intermodal freight, twenty-foot equivalent units (TEUs) are derived from the dimensions of the freight-laden containers. Empty containers are not included in these statistics.

The data are collected via questionnaires and electronic reports that are filed with Statistics Canada eight working days after the reference month. These questionnaires are captured and edited and the data are then aggregated to produce tables for all of Canada and the Eastern and Western divisions of Canada². Tables show the data for the reference month and the year-to-date. These year-to-date figures include revisions of data from previous months.

Users of *Railway Carloadings (Monthly)* current and historical data should be aware of a break in the continuity of these data. Starting with the January 1999 reference period, the commodities presented in the *Railway Carloadings (Monthly)* publication were modified to conform to the Standard Classification of Transported Goods (SCTG) and the number of carriers surveyed more than doubled from the eighteen carriers surveyed prior to 1999.

The additional carriers were primarily shortline carriers whose data were previously included with the data of mainline carriers. The change in commodity classes has had negligible impact on the reporting of bulk commodities (e.g., wheat, potash and coal) which represent the majority of the total number of cars and tonnes. However, the reporting of manufactured and miscellaneous goods has changed significantly.
