Highlights:

- In October 1999, the carload freight (excluding intermodal traffic) loaded by railways in Canada totalled 21.9 million metric tonnes.
- The intermodal tonnage, represented by "container-on-flat-cars" (C.O.F.C.) and "trailer-on-flat-cars" (T.O.F.C.), was 2.2 million metric tonnes.
- The five main loaded commodities, were: iron ores and concentrates (3.5 million metric tonnes), coal (3.5 million metric tonnes), wheat (1.6 million metric tonnes), potash (1.2 million metric tonnes) and lumber (0.9 million metric tonnes).
- The cumulative freight loaded (excluding intermodal traffic) for the first ten months of 1999 reached 196.0 million metric tonnes.


