Highlights

December 2003

Canadian railways carried slightly less tonnage overall in 2003 despite a record-setting second half of the year. Overall, tonnage declined a marginal 0.7% from 2002 to 259.8 million metric tonnes.

During the first half of the year, railways carried 125.1 million metric tonnes, the lowest level since 1999. However, in the second half, they carried a record 134.7 million metric tonnes, up 7.6% from the first six months of 2003.

On a quarterly basis, first-quarter tonnage was the lowest since 1999. However, tonnage rose 5.5% in the second quarter, 1.0% in the third and 7.6% in the fourth, all compared with the previous quarter.

Tonnage for intermodal traffic, which is "containers and trailers on flat cars", rose 6.2% over 2002 to 26.3 million metric tonnes. Non-intermodal traffic was down 1.4% to 233.5 million metric tonnes.

In 2003, intermodal traffic made up 10% of the overall tonnage. This proportion has slowly increased since 1999 where it occupied a little less than 9%.

On a monthly basis, railway carloadings actually increased in December for the first time since 1999. Railways carried 23 million metric tonnes in December, up 100,000 tonnes, or 1%, from November. This was mostly due to a significant increase in wheat loadings and a smaller decline than usual in other commodities.

These top five groups of commodities accounted for 43.7% of the December tonnage and for 37.9% of the car loadings.

In December 2003, the non-intermodal portion of freight loaded on Canadian railroads totalled 265 000 carloads and 20.9 million tonnes. This represents a 1.4% rise from November of this year and a 14.5% increase in tonnage over December of last year. Non intermodal freight represents approximately 91% of the total tonnage loaded on Canadian railways.

Loadings for the intermodal portion, which is "containers and trailers on flat cars", totalled 2.1 million tonnes. Intermodal loadings showed a 7.1% drop from November 2003 and a 3.9% rise from December 2002.

The cumulative total for January to December of 2003 (excluding intermodal loadings) climbed to 233.5 million tonnes, compared with 236.9 million tonnes for the same period in 2002.

Cumulative tonnage for intermodal traffic for January to December reached 26.3 million tonnes, compared with 24.8 million tonnes for the same period of 2002.

Traffic received from the United States destined for Canada or passing through Canada back into the United States reached 2.7 million tonnes, up 1.4% from November. From January to December, U.S. loadings destined for Canada reached 30.8 million tonnes, compared with 26.9 million tonnes in the same period of 2002.

Methodology and concepts

The *Railway Carloadings (Monthly)* publication presents essential data for timely analysis of the Rail Transport Industry and its contribution to the Canadian economy. Approximately 40 rail carriers report each month on their total intermodal and non-intermodal¹ traffic of the previous month. For non-intermodal traffic, the carriers report the number of cars and tonnes by commodity of revenue-generating freight that they have loaded in Canada. For intermodal freight, the carriers report the number of units and tonnes for containers-on-flat-cars (C.O.F.C.) and trailers-on-flat-cars (T.O.F.C.), with no commodity detail. The carriers also report the total tonnage of revenue freight received from United States connections.

The total quantity of freight carried in Canada is the sum of the non-intermodal and intermodal freight loaded and the traffic received from U.S. connections. Additional information provided includes the number of units and tonnes of C.O.F.C. and T.O.F.C received from U.S. connections and the total tonnes of cargo that the carriers received from other Canadian connections. This freight that is exchanged among Canadian based carriers is counted only once in the total quantity of freight moved as it is counted only when loaded. For intermodal freight, twenty-foot equivalent units (TEUs) are derived from the dimensions of the freight-laden containers. Empty containers are not included in these statistics.

The data are collected via questionnaires and electronic reports that are filed with Statistics Canada eight working days after the reference month. These questionnaires are captured and edited and the data are then aggregated to produce tables for all of Canada and the Eastern and Western divisions of Canada². Tables show the data for the reference month and the year-to-date. These year-to-date figures include revisions of data from previous months.

Users of *Railway Carloadings (Monthly)* current and historical data should be aware of a break in the continuity of these data. Starting with the January 1999 reference period, the commodities presented in the *Railway Carloadings (Monthly)* publication were modified to conform to the Standard Classification of Transported Goods (SCTG) and the number of carriers surveyed more than doubled from the eighteen carriers surveyed prior to 1999.

The additional carriers were primarily shortline carriers whose data were previously included with the data of mainline carriers. The change in commodity classes has had negligible impact on the reporting of bulk commodities (e.g., wheat, potash and coal) which represent the majority of the total number of cars and tonnes. However, the reporting of manufactured and miscellaneous goods has changed significantly.
