Highlights:

- In January 2000, the freight loaded by railways in Canada (excluding intermodal traffic) totalled 19.6 million metric tonnes. This represented an increase of 11.9% compared to January 1999.
- The intermodal tonnage, represented by "container-on-flat-cars" (C.O.F.C.) and "trailer-on-flat-cars" (T.O.F.C.) increased by 15.8% compared to the same period in 1999, to reach 1.9 million metric tonnes.
- The five main loaded commodities were: coal (3.1 million metric tonnes), iron ores and concentrates (2.8 million metric tonnes), wheat (1.6 million metric tonnes), potash (1.4 million metric tonnes) and lumber (0.9 million metric tonnes). Among the five main loaded commodities, iron ores and concentrates and lumber recorded strong increases of 48.0% and 44.2%, respectively, compared to January 1999.

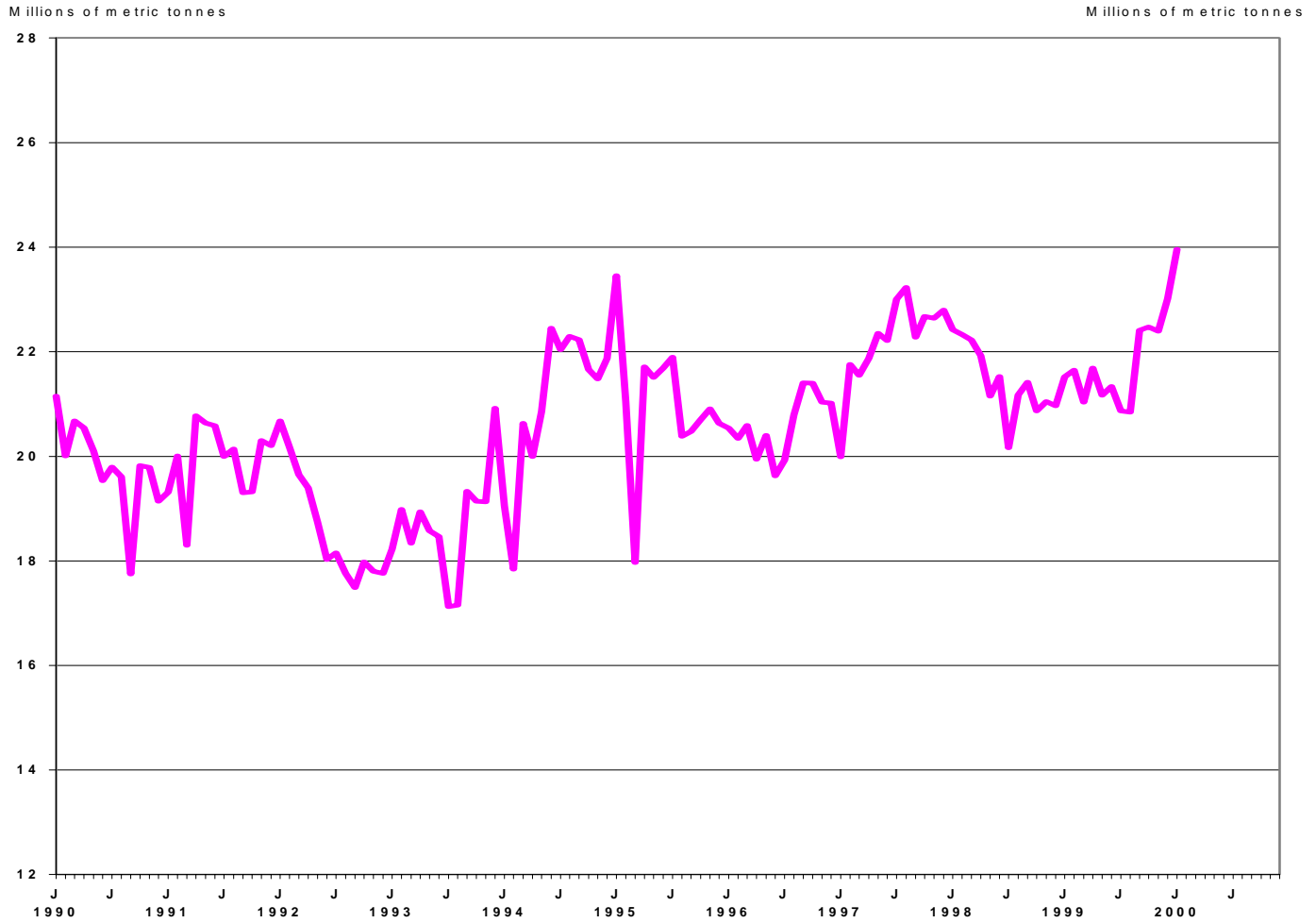
