## Part III Review—*Canada Labour Code*

Review of Federal Labour Standards—The Federal Labour Standards Review Commission will be holding public hearings in the fall of 2005 in 14 cities across Canada. The mandate of the Commission is to conduct a comprehensive review of Part III of the *Canada Labour Code* which sets out labour standards for workers and employers under federal jurisdiction.

Federal labour standards currently address such issues as hours of work, minimum wage, unjust dismissals and annual vacation. The Commission hopes to hear a broad range of views on various workplace issues related to its mandate.
