FUNDING TO MANITOBA, 1997-98

- In 1997-98, the Canada Council for the Arts provided grants worth \$5.4 million to the arts in Manitoba. This includes an additional \$971,000 in grants to Manitoba artists and arts organizations as a result of new funds received by the Council.
- In addition, over \$163,000 in payments was provided to 326 Manitoba authors through the Public Lending Right Program¹. This brings the total amount of Canada Council funding to Manitoba to \$5.6 million.
- The Council awarded \$532,000 in grants to 49 Manitoba artists and \$4.9 million to 71 Manitoba arts organizations².
- Grants were provided in every artistic discipline - dance, music, theatre, visual arts, media arts, writing and publishing and interdisciplinary art. The largest amount of funding (\$1.6 million) went to dance, followed by music (\$1.4 million) and theatre (\$975,000).
- \$5.2 million in Council funding went to artists and arts organizations in Winnipeg, making up over (97%) of the funding going to the province. In total, all other communities in Manitoba received \$159,000 (about 3% of the total).
- 26 Manitoba artists and arts professionals served as peer assessors in 1997-98, making up 4.3% of all peer assessors.
- Manitoba artists and arts organizations received 5.7% of Canada Council funding. In comparison, the province makes up approximately 3.2% of individuals in professional and technical occupations in the arts and 3.9% of the population of Canada.
- According to the 1996 Census, there are 9,950 individuals in professional and technical occupations in the arts in Manitoba³. This represents a 2.3% increase over 1991.

¹ **The Public Lending Right Program provides payments to authors whose books are held in selected Canadian libraries.**

² **Number of arts organizations excludes host organizations such as libraries, post-secondary institutions, bookstores and other organizations participating in the Literary Readings Program.**
