


Chart 3.0 - Distribution by Level of Compendial Product Licence Applications Currently Being Worked On.

Chart 3.0 - Distribution by Level of Compendial Product Licence Applications Currently Being Worked On











Chart 9.0 - Site Licence Applications Received and Completed Since March 2007




Chart 10.0 - Site Licence Applications Completed (i.e. Licensed and Withdrawn/Refused) since March 2007.




Chart 11.0 - Distribution by Level of Site Licence Applications Currently Being Worked On.




Chart 14.0 - Flow of Site Licence Amendments, Notifications and Renewals Received and Completed since March 2007.

Chart 15.0 - Distribution by Level of Site Licence Amendments, Notifications and Renewals Currently Being Worked On.




Chart 15.0 - Distribution by Level of Site Licence Amendments, Notifications and Renewals Currently Being Worked On
