Simplified Canadian Passport Renewal



Get your new passport with fewer steps

Want to get your new passport in fewer steps and by using a simpler, shorter form? If you can answer “yes” to the following eligibility questions, Passport Canada’s SIMPLIFIED RENEWAL Passport Application may be for you.

- Are you a Canadian citizen?
- At the time you applied for your previous passport, were you at least 16 years of age?
- Can you submit a previous Canadian passport with your application that:
 - was issued in Canada (as indicated under “Issuing Authority” on page 2 of the submitted passport);
 - was issued to you within the last SIX (6) years (if you applied for your last passport by mail from the USA, it must have been issued on or after August 1, 2003);
 - was/is valid for FIVE (5) years;
 - is **not** damaged; and
 - was **never** reported as being lost or stolen?
- Will the name on your application form be exactly the same as the name on page 2 of your submitted passport?
- If you live in the USA, will you submit your application:
 - by mail to Canada, or
 - in person in Canada?

You’re on your way

If you meet these basic requirements, our Simplified Passport Renewal Process lets you apply using a shorter application form, without a guarantor, and without submitting proof of Canadian citizenship and supporting identification.

Renewal applications remain subject to all current security verifications.

Where to get your application

A SIMPLIFIED RENEWAL Passport Application form can be obtained at any Passport Canada service location, Service Canada Centre or Canada Post office. It can also be downloaded from Passport Canada’s website at: www.passportcanada.gc.ca.



How to apply

The SIMPLIFIED RENEWAL Passport Application form can be used to submit an application:

- by mail within Canada,
- by mail to Canada from the USA, or
- in person in Canada.

A Canadian passport is the only reliable and universally accepted travel and identification document available to Canadians for the purpose of international travel. Passport Canada advises travellers to always carry a valid passport for all trips outside Canada.
