Highlights

Date Released: 2010

- The vacancy rate in Quebec changed little over the past year, reaching 8.4 per cent in 2010.
- The rental results varied significantly from one area to another.
- Smaller units dominated the market, with room-and-board units accounting for nearly 40 per cent of the universe.
- In February 2010, it cost an average of \$1,393 per month to live in a retirement home in the province.
- The retirement homes surveyed attracted 17.8 per cent of the population aged 75 years or older.




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
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
VACANCY RATES

Vacancy rate rises slightly in Quebec

According to the latest annual Seniors' Housing Survey conducted by Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC), the vacancy rate for standard spaces—spaces for persons requiring less than one and a half hours of medical care per day—changed little over the past year in the province of Quebec, having reached 8.4 per cent in February 2010, versus 7.9 per cent at the same time in 2009.

The change in the overall rate resulted from softer conditions in the private room segment. In fact, the vacancy rate for units of this type attained 10.1 per cent this year, compared to 8.9 per cent in 2009. In the apartment segment, the vacancy rates remained relatively stable. In fact, in 2010, the proportions of unoccupied units reached 8.5 per cent for bachelor apartments and 7 per cent in the case of apartments with one or more bedrooms.

The current easing has also been due to the fact that the supply of residential care units has been rising faster than demand. Over the past decade, Quebec saw its population aged 75 years or older grow rapidly. Construction largely met the increase in potential demand but, on account of the decline in births during the years of the Great Depression, the province has entered a period where the growth in the population aged 75 years or older is slowing down.

As well, the trend observed in recent years has been to build larger and larger buildings. While unit rentals may begin before projects are completed, it is not rare that some units are still vacant at the time of the survey, that is, at least 12 months after completion. The arrival of many units at the same time therefore results in longer absorption periods, which tends to cause the market to ease.

The constant increase in substitute

housing types has also contributed to keeping the vacancy rate at the current level. The traditional rental market—where meal services and medical care are not offered—and the condominium apartment segment can meet the needs of some senior clients, which curbs demand for retirement home units.

Lastly, while the growth in the Quebec population aged 75 years or older is slowing down, the people in this cohort are aging and needing more care. In fact, market conditions tightened for heavy care spaces over the past year, as the vacancy rate for such units fell from 11.7 per cent in 2009 to 7.1 per cent in 2010. Heavy care spaces are spaces where the residents receive at least one and a half hours of medical care per day. The survey includes nearly 5,000 heavy care spaces, which represents just over 5 per cent of the market covered.

Marked differences from one CMA to another

The retirement home rental results varied significantly from one census metropolitan area (CMA) to another in Quebec. Like last year, the Saguenay area had the lowest vacancy rate for standard spaces (3.4 per cent) among the six CMAs in the province, and the Gatineau area was contending with the highest (21.3 per cent). The rental results in the Montréal, Québec and Sherbrooke areas were similar to the provincial average, while Trois-Rivières stood out with 5.1 per cent of its units vacant.

While the vacancy rate was still relatively low this year in the Saguenay area, the market eased from 2009, when the vacancy rate was 1.6 per cent there. This change resulted more from the increase in the vacancy rate for rooms (from 2.5 per cent in 2009 to 4.8 per cent in 2010), since the rate for apartments went from 0.8 per cent to 2.1 per cent. As well, only two-bedroom apartments saw their proportion of unoccupied units decrease and, furthermore, such units showed no vacancies in February 2010, while their vacancy rate was 2 per cent last year.

The vacancy rates also increased in the Gatineau, Québec and Montréal areas over the past year. However, contrary to what happened in the Saguenay area, where the number of standard spaces remained relatively stable in 2010 compared to 2009, supply rose in the three largest urban centres.

In Gatineau, the addition of new spaces caused the vacancy rate for standard spaces to increase from 17.2 per cent in 2009 to 21.3 per

cent this year. The vacancy rate hike was observed especially in the case of smaller apartments. In 2009, only 9 per cent of bachelor units were vacant while, in 2010, this proportion was 23.7 per cent. The vacancy rate for one-bedroom units also went up, rising from 24.2 per cent to 29.2 per cent. Two-bedroom units posted a better result this year than last year, but their vacancy rate still remained high, at 17.3 per cent. Only roomand-board units—the supply of which remained relatively stable—had a rate below the 10-per-cent mark.

In the Québec area, the arrival of new apartments on the market had an impact on the overall vacancy rate. In fact, this rate reached 8.1 per cent in 2010, up from 7.1 per cent a year earlier. Over the past year, the supply of rooms remained stable, while the supply of apartments climbed by 12 per cent. As a result, while the vacancy rate decreased for rooms, the market eased for apartments (with the rate rising to 8.5 per cent in 2010 from 6.8 per cent in 2009).

In Montréal, it was in the private room segment that the vacancy rate rose, while the rate for apartments fell. Given that the supply of apartments increased more significantly than the supply of room-and-board units, the decrease in the vacancy rate for apartments reflected the appeal of these units among the target client group in this area. The vacancy rate consequently remained higher for room-and-board units than for apartments. Only private rooms showed a vacancy rate increase in 2010.

In the Trois-Rivières CMA, market conditions remained stable and relatively tight. In fact, the proportion of unoccupied standard spaces reached 5.1 per cent in 2010 (compared to 5.3 per cent in 2009). The fact that the inventory of spaces for independent seniors remained stable between the 2009 and 2010 surveys allowed the vacancy rate to stay close to the same level in the area. This stability was apparent for smaller units (private rooms and bachelor units). Conditions eased for one-bedroom apartments (vacancy rate of 5.5 per cent), while they tightened for two-bedroom units (4.4 per cent).

It was in the Sherbrooke area that the stable supply had the greatest effect on the retirement home market. In fact, the vacancy rate there decreased from 9.7 per cent to 7.8 per cent between 2009 and 2010. The drop in the overall rate was attributable to the decreases in the rates for bachelor units and one-bedroom apartments.

Results just as varied in other area across Quebec

The census agglomerations (CAs) of Saint-Hyacinthe, Drummondville and Cowansville stood out with relatively soft market conditions. The vacancy rates in these three areas were above 11 per cent. Conversely, the Rimouski and Saint-Georges CAs had vacancy rates below 2 per cent. The vast majority of the CAs had lower vacancy rates than the provincial average.

In the rural areas, the vacancy rates varied even more. The Capitale-Nationale rural area and the Lanaudière rural area had the softest market conditions, with proportions of unoccupied units exceeding 15 per cent (see Table 1.1).

CAPTURE RATE

Trois-Rivières and Sherbrooke retirement homes attract the most residents

Every year, construction gets under way on new retirement homes across Quebec. The new spaces added to the market are generating growing interest among seniors. This has led to an increase in the capture rate. Overall, in 2010, the retirement homes in Quebec attracted 17.8 per cent of the population aged 75 years or older in the province while, last year, the capture rate was 17.2 per cent.


Trois-Rivières and Sherbrooke had the highest capture rates, at 24.3 per cent and 25.5 per cent. In the other CMAs, the rates were slightly higher than the provincial average, except in Montréal, where this rate was 17.5 per cent.


UNIVERSE

Smaller units dominate the market

Across Quebec, 2.6 per cent of households lived in retirement homes in 2010. The province had a universe of close to 95,000 spaces to accommodate them. Room-and-board units accounted for 40 per cent of this universe. One-bedroom apartments came in second with 32 per cent of all spaces. Bachelor units followed with 15 per cent, and two-bedroom apartments brought up the rear with 12 per cent.

Standard spaces accounted for close to 94 per cent of all spaces surveyed. The remainder of the universe was mainly composed of heavy care spaces (5 per cent). While still marginal, this segment could grow with the continued aging of the population.





The CMAs had more than two thirds of the spaces for independent seniors, or about 60,200 spaces out of a total of around 88,700. Montréal, the most populous urban centre, had nearly 44 per cent of the standard spaces in the province. The Québec area ranked second, with a proportion of just 11 per cent. The other CMAs


followed behind the leaders, with little difference among them. However, the Sherbrooke area stood out somewhat from the others, with 3,600 spaces, more than the number recorded in the Gatineau area, the third largest area in Quebec in terms of population.


More large apartments in the more populous centres

Saguenay and Sherbrooke had the largest proportions of private rooms, as units of this type accounted for half of the universe of standard spaces in Saguenay and 46 per cent in Sherbrooke. Elsewhere, they represented one quarter of the universe.

As for apartments, Trois-Rivières had the greatest concentration of bachelor units, with units of this type accounting for 28 per cent of the spaces in this urban centre, followed by Gatineau, with 20 per cent, while Sherbrooke came in last, with 13 per cent.

With a proportion of about 40 per cent of the universe, one-bedroom apartments largely dominated the other unit types in the Montréal, Québec and Gatineau areas. Lastly, two-bedroom apartments accounted for 17 per cent of the total in Montréal and Gatineau, while they made up only 7 per cent of the standard spaces in Saguenay.





Spotlight on...

Rents

Rent is unquestionably a determining factor in the choices made by renters. It therefore came as no surprise to see that the vacancy rate was higher (10.8 per cent) for standard spaces in the upper rent range (\$1,601 or more). It was surprising, though, that the proportion of unoccupied units was just as high (10.4 per cent) for spaces in the lower rent range (less than \$901). This could be attributable to the fact that a number of these units are contained in residences that offer fewer services and/or are less recent. In the other rent ranges, the vacancy rates varied between 7 per cent and 8 per cent.

Larger synonymous with higher rents

The average rent for standard spaces in retirement homes in Quebec reached around \$1,400 per month

in 2010. In general, rents rise with unit size. However, the survey results revealed that the average rents for private and semi-private rooms were higher than the average for bachelor apartments, which are generally larger. The explanation lies in the fact that rents for rooms include meals, which is not always the case for bachelor apartments. In fact, residents had to pay more than \$1,300, on average, for room-andboard units and \$1,200 for bachelor units. The average rents reached \$1,400 for one-bedroom apartments and close to \$1,800 for twobedroom apartments. In the case of heavy care spaces, the average rent was over \$2,600. It should be recalled that units of this type are intended for residents needing at least one and a half hours of care per day, so the difference results from the services.

Rents were higher in the major centres. In fact, only the Gatineau,

Montréal and Québec areas had rents for standard spaces above the provincial average. The overall average rent in Gatineau stood at \$1,768 in February 2010, or nearly \$400 more than the provincial average, while the averages were \$1,505 in Québec and \$1,454 in Montréal. These differences in rents can be explained by the greater number of recently built, high quality structures offering more services and amenities in major centres. Elsewhere, the rents were closer to the provincial average.

Methodology

Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation conducted the National Seniors' Housing Survey in February and March. This annual survey began in 2009. The survey was conducted in all centres in all ten provinces.

The survey targeted private or non-profit residences where the majority of residents are 65 years of age or older and have access to additional services not offered in traditional rental structures. Examples of such services include meal service, housekeeping and laundry. To be eligible for the survey, a residence must provide an on-site meal plan. (This eligibility requirement differs from the previous year's survey, which required either on-site meal plan or on-site medical services).

However, the survey excluded seniors' residences which provide high levels of healthcare (defined as 1.5 hours or more of care per day) to all of their residents. Nursing homes and long-term care homes are examples of residences that were not included in the survey. As well, residences with less than 10 units were excluded in Québec, Ontario and the Prairies, and with less than 5 units were excluded in Atlantic and British Columbia Regions.

Survey data were obtained through a combination of telephone interviews and fax and email responses. Information was obtained from the owner, manager, or residence administrator. Survey results reflect market conditions at the time of the survey. Survey results have been weighted to adjust for non-responses, to ensure that they are reflective of the universe. 2009 data in this publication may differ from what was published last year, due to survey zone changes in 2010. The level of statistical reliability is noted in the data tables. For more information on the reliability of the data please click here.

All statistics published, excluding information on new market supply, include only those residences that have been in operation for at least one year.

Definitions

Space: A space is a residential area that is rented out. Examples of spaces include: one-half of a semi-private unit, a private or bachelor unit, a one-bedroom unit and a two-bedroom unit. In most cases a space is the same as a unit. The exception is the case where a unit has been divided to rent to multiple residents. Semi-private and ward units are an example of this. Unless otherwise indicated, data for spaces are for all unit types.

Standard Space: A space occupied by a resident who does not receive high levels of care (i.e. the resident receives less than 1.5 hours of care per day.) Regional terms for this type of space vary across the country, and, in cases where there is no additional charge for additional care, it is possible that the standard space estimate includes some units with additional care.

Heavy Care Space: A space where the residence provides 1.5 hours or more of healthcare per day to the resident. Examples include Alzheimer, Dementia and mobility support residents.

Respite Space: A space used to provide temporary accommodation for a senior who normally lives in another place and not at the residence.

Non-market or Subsidy Space: A space where the rent received for the unit is less than market rent or where the resident occupying the unit is subsidized.

Rent: The rent refers to the actual amount residents pay for their space and all mandatory services. Charges for additional non-mandatory services are excluded from the rent. For vacant spaces, the rent is the amount the owner is asking for the space.

Vacancy: A space is considered vacant if, at the time of the survey, it is physically unoccupied and available for immediate rental.
